The spiritual value of a Word Watch

Declaring the Word of God by reading it aloud.



One of Jesus' titles is Word of God (Rev.19:13; John 1:1-5). When we read the Bible, we honour both God's written word and Jesus as the Word.

Testimony about Jesus is the spirit of prophecy (Rev.19:10). Reading and proclaiming the New Testament is prophesying. God's Word will never return empty, but it will accomplish God's will (Isa.55:11).

The Word of God is spirit and is life (John 6:63). When we proclaim the Word, we believe that the Spirit of God will use the Word to bring life – in us and in the world around us.

The Word of God is the Sword of the Spirit (Eph.2:6). The Spirit uses the Word of God to give discernment, especially between things of the soul (flesh) and things of the spirit, and to expose lies and reveal truth (Heb.4:12).

The Word of God creates (Gen.1) and sustains the world (Heb.1:3). The words coming from our mouths also create – either life or death (Prov.18:21). We can thus speak God's word into circumstances around us and create life.

The Word of God is the seed of the Gospel. If implanted in a person's heart, it brings about salvation (Luk.8:11; Jam.1:21).

The Word of God increases faith and aids spiritual growth (Rom.10:17; 1 Pet.2:2). The more Word we hear, the stronger our faith becomes and the more mature we become.

The Word of God is truth, and truth will set us free from bondages and break strongholds (John 17:17; John 8:31-32; Jer.23:29).

The Word of God guides us through life and gives us wisdom (Ps.119:130,133).

The Word of God heals, delivers and helps us to overcome evil (Matt.8:8; Ps.119:170; 1 John 2:14).
