

THE GOSPEL IN THE SOUTH AFRICAN FLAG

GOLD: HEAVEN – God has prepared heaven as a gift for each one of us, but reality is that "the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life" (Rom 6:23).

BLACK: SIN – "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God" (Rom 3:23).

RED: SALVATION - Only by the Blood of Jesus that was shed on the cross, can we be saved from sin (1 John 1:7-9, Rom. 5:8; Heb. 9:22b).

WHITE: PURITY – His blood washes away and forgives us of all our sin (Rom 10:9-10).

BLUE: FAITH – Take God at His Word. Invite Jesus into your life and ask Him to fill you with the Holy Spirit (John 4:14, 16-18, 26).

GREEN: GROW – In Christ we begin to grow spiritually. As a tree grows and bears fruit, so we too must grow by reading the Bible, prayer and obedience. (2 Pet 3:18; Eph 4:15).

Prayer: *Heavenly Father, I have sinned against You. I repent of my sins today, and choose to make You, Lord Jesus, my Saviour and Lord of my life. Wash me and cleanse me from all my sins; make me new and fill me with the Holy Spirit and the love of Jesus Christ. Give me a hunger for Your Word (the Bible) and help me to become a witness to others of Your LOVE in my life. Amen.*
