Thank you to every believer, local congregation and 24-7 prayer ministry who joined us during 2024 to pray night and day for revival among the nations. Here are some of the highlights of 2024...

Millions praying for World Evangelisation

There is a growing movement of collaboration among Christian ministries and networks. The International Prayer Connect is such an example of prayer networks collaborating across the globe. Under this banner, four 'Global Days of Prayer' were established that continued during 2024, with thousands of believers around the world praying for salvation of peoples from the Buddhist, Muslim, Jewish and Hindu faiths. 24-7 Prayer for Revival

The '7 Days on the Wall' prayer initiative was birthed at the World Prayer Assembly, Indonesia, in 2012, calling local congregations to take one week per year to pray day and night for revival among the nations of the world. Since January 2013, this move of prayer has spread from South Africa to 40 nations across Africa, Europe and Asia. During 2024, we have seen an increase of 25 percent in the number of 24-7 prayer groups that participated in regular weeks of prayer. Thirty three percent of these groups are praying 24-7-365. The city of Cape Town has 12 such ongoing '24-7 Prayer Watches' praying for revival among the nations.

❖ Increase in Bible Translation

One Bible Translation ministry started participating in our annual 24-7 week of prayer for Bible translation in 2022. Since then, the number of translation projects they undertake across the world has increased from 143 in 2022 to more than 350 in 2024.

❖ Compassion for the 'Suffering Church'

Partnering with Open Doors Southern Africa, more than 120 groups from 21 nations across Africa, Europe and South Asia prayed for the 'Suffering Church' in Sub Saharan Africa during November. We prayed for the protection of God's people and the advancement of His kingdom in these nations. This

was the most active 24-7 prayer week of the year, clearly showing that God's suffering children are close to His heart.

WSOP 2024

This year the 23rd Annual Watchman's School was held in Cape Town, with almost 100 delegates from 16 nations attending. As a result of this gathering, new 24-7 Prayer Watches have been established in Togo, Kenya, Zambia, South Sudan, India, Pakistan and the UAE. We thank the Lord for building His House of Prayer among the nations.

New Global Connections

We thank the Lord for His favour in establishing new relationships with prayer networks/movements globally. Some of these include the International Prayer Connect, 10 Days Movement, various regional networks, Campus Crusade for Christ, various Bible Translation Ministries, Open Doors and Unlimited Prayer Frontiers.

40-Day Bible Reading Challenge

Last year more than 800 Christians joined us in reading the Bible from 1 December 2023 to 9 January 2024. This year we are again inviting you and your fellow believers to join us in reading/declaring His word for 40 days, 1 December 2024 to 9 January 2025.
