24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL 5-11 MAY 2025

CHRIST REVEALED ENCOUNTER HIS CHARACTER

In week one of our series 'Christ revealed', we explored personal encounters with the risen Jesus. In week two, we focused on His name.

In this last week of the series we focus on encountering Jesus' character through a deep relationship with Him. Pray that people in your community will reflect His character—even in hardship—knowing that He, too, faced challenges in the flesh.

MONDAY 5 MAY 2025 COMPASSIONATE

*But when He saw the multitudes, He was **moved with compassion for them**, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. (Matthew 9:36).*

Jesus deeply cared for others, healing the sick, feeding the hungry and comforting the broken, revealing God's heart through His compassion.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to teach you to see others through His eyes and respond with His compassion in every circumstance.
 - Pray that every act of kindness from believers will reflect His mercy, drawing unbelievers in your neighbourhood who experience trauma to know Him personally.
 - Pray for their hearts to be touched, their burdens to be lifted and their lives to be transformed as they experience the love and tenderness of Jesus through His people.
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TUESDAY 6 MAY 2025

OBEDIENT UNTO DEATH

...He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. (Philippians 2:8).

Jesus fully obeyed the Father, even unto death on the cross, showing perfect love for God and submission to His will.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to help you deny yourself and walk in obedience, even when it costs you the loss of comfort, pride, or control.
- Pray for those in rebellion in your community to encounter Jesus' radical obedience unto death through believers' unwavering faithfulness. Ask that the power of His sacrifice would soften their hearts.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to convict unbelievers through the humble obedience of believers. Pray for the believers' lives to reflect Jesus' submission and love, stirring a hunger for truth, repentance and transformation.

WEDNESDAY 7 MAY 2025

LOVING

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another. (John 13:34).

Jesus loved—offering grace, truth and sacrifice to all—regardless of status, past mistakes, or whether they would love Him in return.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to help you love without limits—friends, enemies, and strangers—just like Jesus, through the power of the Holy Spirit.
- Lift up those in the Church experiencing divorce and who do not yet know the Lord. Pray that they encounter His unfailing love through the gentle care of believers around them.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to make believers vessels of healing. May every word and action flow with Christlike love, restoring wounded hearts and minds within the Church.

THURSDAY 8 MAY 2025

HUMBLE

Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,... made Himself of no reputation,... (Philippians 2:5-7).

Jesus was born in a manger, washed feet, served others and never sought His own glory—true humility in action.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to strip away pride from your heart. Pray that He teaches you to serve others humbly, just as Jesus did, without seeking recognition.
- Lift up the CEOs in your city who misuse their authority. Ask the Holy Spirit to convict them and lead them to repentance through the humility of Christ reflected in believers.
- Pray for CEOs to encounter Jesus, resulting in personal transformation and a new way of leading others with love.

FRIDAY 9 MAY 2025

MEEK

...I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. (Matthew 11:29).

Jesus was strong yet gentle, never retaliating with pride or violence but responding to hostility with controlled strength and grace.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to teach you to be meek like Him—strong in conviction, yet gentle in your approach toward those who oppose you.
- Pray that the Lord will strengthen high school teachers overwhelmed by difficult student behaviour. May they witness His meekness—strength guided by humility—shining through the lives of believing colleagues and parents.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to encourage weary teachers facing daily challenges. May meek and gracious believers around them uplift their spirits and point them to the peace of Jesus.

SATURDAY 10 MAY 2025

BOLD

..."MY HOUSE SHALL BE CALLED A HOUSE OF PRAYER,' but you have made it a 'DEN OF THIEVES.'" (Matthew 21:13).

Jesus boldly confronted evil, hypocrisy and injustice with truth and authority, never shrinking from His mission despite opposition or danger.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to give you boldness to stand for truth and justice, even when it's unpopular or difficult.
- Lift up the pastors in your community who are being attacked through gossip and slander. Pray that their integrity will speak louder than the rumours and that their voices remain anchored in God's Word.
- Pray that they will not be swayed by public opinion or pressured to defend themselves but will trust that no weapon formed against them will prosper.

SUNDAY 11 MAY 2025

FAITHFUL

But the Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one. (2 Thessalonians 3:3).

Jesus faithfully completed His mission, kept every promise and still intercedes for us with the Father—He is ever dependable, loyal and true.

Let us pray

- Ask Jesus to strengthen your faithfulness to Him, to endure trials and remain loyal daily.
- Pray for orphans in your community who feel abandoned and alone. Ask that they encounter God's unfailing love and come to know that He will never leave nor forsake them.
- Ask the Lord to bring deep healing through interaction with Christians to the hearts of these children who have experienced rejection and loss. May they experience His faithfulness, compassion and care—the very heart of Jesus!
