24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL

16-22 June 2025

We invite you to join us in prayer this second week of a four-part series, which focuses on 'Social Security', 'The Government', 'The Church', and 'Education'.

Set aside time this second week to pray for your country's Government and for nations in conflict. Ask the Lord to help government leaders walk in wisdom, to uphold justice, seek peace and govern with integrity. Pray for the Holy Spirit to be poured out on every government, guiding their leaders' hearts to fear the Lord.

MONDAY 16 JUNE 2025

RIGHTEOUSNESS

Righteousness exalts a nation... (Proverbs 14:34).

Indonesia's conflict with Papua New Guinea involves territorial disputes and separatist movements in Papua seeking independence.

Indonesia is a democratic republic with a presidential system, elected leaders, a multi-party legislature, an independent judiciary and decentralised governance across 38 provinces.

Let us pray

- Pray for leaders in your country to love righteousness and hate injustice, reflecting God's goodness and desire for fairness.
- Ask God to establish His righteousness in every department of government in Indonesia, for *blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord* (Psalm 33:12).

TUESDAY 17 JUNE 2025

JUSTICE

He has shown you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justly... (Micah 6:8).

Laos currently has no active conflicts with other countries. It maintains generally peaceful relations with neighbours like Thailand, Vietnam and China.

Laos is a one-party socialist republic led by the Lao People's Revolutionary Party, which has controlled the government, military and media since 1975.

Let us pray

- Pray for leaders in your country to execute true justice—it reflects God's character and is required for a right relationship with Him and others.
- Ask God for His justice to break through in Laos; being just means loving our neighbour not only in words, but in demonstration.

WEDNESDAY 18 JUNE 2025

HUMILITY

Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant. (Matthew 20:26).

Myanmar has border tensions with Bangladesh, India and China due to refugee flows, ethnic conflicts and military clashes spilling across borders.

Myanmar's military-led government seized power in 2021, suppressing democracy, restricting freedoms and as a result, it faces resistance from ethnic groups and pro-democracy forces.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to give your leaders humility; serving others mirrors Jesus' character and allows the Holy Spirit to transform pride into purpose and position into humility.
- Pray for leaders in Myanmar who wield power and authority; that God would transform their hearts to mirror His.

THURSDAY 19 JUNE 2025

WISDOM

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. (James 1:5).

Taiwan faces complex geopolitical tensions involving several countries, primarily due to its disputed status and strategic significance. The key nations involved are China, Russia, North Korea, Myanmar and the Philippines. Taiwan is a semi-presidential republic with a five-branch government system, emphasising democratic values and civil liberties.

Let us pray

- Pray for leaders in your country to ask God for godly wisdom, because human wisdom is limited and they need His eternal perspective.
- Ask the Lord to raise up leaders in Taiwan with spiritual insight that flows from a reverent relationship with Him.

FRIDAY 20 JUNE 2025

TRUSTWORTHY

He who walks with integrity walks securely... (Proverbs 10:9).

Malaysia protested the Philippines' maritime laws over long-standing territorial claims. Maritime disputes with Indonesia also persist, whereas relations with Thailand remain peaceful.

Malaysia has a federal constitutional monarchy with a parliamentary system, where the king serves as a ceremonial head of state.

Let us pray

- Pray for the leaders of your country to be trustworthy, for Jesus walked in perfect integrity. His words, actions and heart were aligned with the Father's will.
- Ask the Lord to raise up leaders in Malaysia with integrity, the foundation of true leadership, as His throne is built on righteousness and integrity.

SATURDAY 21 JUNE 2025

PEACE AND TRUTH

... Seek peace and pursue it. (Psalm 34:14).

India faces territorial disputes with several neighbouring countries, rooted in historical agreements, colonial-era boundaries and strategic interests. These countries include Pakistan, China, Nepal, Bangladesh, Myanmar and Sri Lanka.

India is a federal democratic parliamentary republic with a bicameral legislature, a ceremonial president and an executive led by the prime minister.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to unite your country's leaders in peace and truth, for God is the God of peace and pursuing peace reflects His character in us.
 - Pray for peace in India and for them to choose reconciliation over conflict.
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SUNDAY 22 JUNE 2025

GOD'S AUTHORITY

For there is no authority except from God... (Romans 13:1).

Pakistan is in conflict with India over Kashmir, with ongoing territorial disputes. Tensions with Afghanistan and the United States of America persist over terrorism.

Pakistan is a federal parliamentary republic with a president as ceremonial head of state and a prime minister as executive leader.

Let us pray

- Pray for the leaders in your country to recognise God's authority, for in doing so, they acknowledge Him as the sovereign ruler of all creation.
 - Ask the Lord to humble every heart in Pakistan that exalts itself above Him, for He must increase and we must decrease (John 3:30). Humility elevates Jesus' presence, influence and glory above our ambitions, pride or desire for recognition.
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
