10 Days of Prayer for Revival in the Church



Week 3: 30 May - 8 June 2025

PRAYER GUIDE

During the 10 days leading up to Pentecost Sunday, we invite you to pray with us for Revival in the Church. This global collaboration between various prayer networks culminates in the Global Day of Prayer for Revival and the Jewish World (8 June 2025).

Why Revival?

In Acts 1:8, Jesus declared this word before His ascension to heaven: *"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."*

Why the Jews?

In Romans 10:1, Paul expressed his heart's desire for Israel's salvation: *Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved.* Let us also pray for Jewish unbelievers around the world to call on their Messiah, the Lord Jesus Christ, and be saved!

There are approximately **15 million Jews** worldwide, with **6 million** residing in Israel.

However, only about **1%** of the Jewish population identifies as Messianic believers.

According to **Joshua Project**, over **5 million Jews** in Israel remain unreached, with many others in Jewish communities worldwide still waiting to hear the message of salvation.

Consider the following:

- Take a few minutes daily to pray according to these guidelines.
- Have a special time of corporate prayer in your local church.

It can be meaningful to read the daily prayer pointer, reflect on the Scripture, and then pray as the Holy Spirit leads you.



DAY 1: 30 MAY 2025

HUMILITY

... you shall remember that the Lord your God led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you and test you, to know what was in your heart... (Deuteronomy 8:2).

Scripture reading: Deuteronomy 8

Let us pray

For the Church

- Humble yourself before God and ask Him to reveal the state of your heart. Confess any **discontentment or prideful thoughts** you have held toward Him during difficult seasons.
- Pray for your local church members to **submit to God**, allowing Him to shape their hearts through His loving discipline.

For the Jewish World

- Pray for Jews to *remember God* – His goodness, mercy, salvation, etc. – and not harden their hearts towards Him, but **humbly keep His commands**.
- Also pray for them to turn their hearts from idolatry.



DAY 2: 31 MAY 2025

SALVATION

Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved. (Romans 10:1).

Scripture reading: Romans 10

Let us pray

For the Church

- Praise the Lord for the **salvation made available to the Gentiles through the Jews**.
- Pray for believers in minority Christian nations to **proclaim the salvation of the Lord daily, declaring His glory and marvellous works**.

For the Jewish World

- **Confess any antisemitism** (discrimination or acts of hostility toward Jewish people) personally, and on behalf of your nation and the Church. Earnestly **seek the Lord's forgiveness**.
- Pray for the **Gospel to be preached in large Jewish communities** in cities like New York, Paris, London, Vancouver, Moscow and Buenos Aires.



DAY 3: 1 JUNE 2025

GOD'S LAW

"I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people." (Jeremiah 31:33b).

Scripture reading: Jeremiah 31:31-34

Let us pray

For the Church

- Pray for the **global Church to grow in the knowledge of God** through the consistent practice of Bible study, prayer and times of quiet reflection.
- Ask the Lord to **revive hearts through His Word**, resulting in Bible study groups in your city or town.

For the Jewish World

- Pray for **Messianic Jews to share their testimonies and encounters with Jesus**, turning unbelieving hearts to Him.
- Call on God for the **Jewish youth to explore the New Testament**, discovering Jesus as the Living Word as they read the written Word.



DAY 4: 2 JUNE 2025

NEW HEART AND SPIRIT

I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit within you... (Ezekiel 36:26a).

Scripture reading: Ezekiel 36:22-32

Let us pray

For the Church

- Ask the Holy Spirit to convict believers in your nation of **heart issues that reflect a hardened spirit**, such as jealousy, arrogance, bitterness, selfishness and more.
- Pray that as believers submit to the Holy Spirit, the fruit of the Spirit will impact those around them (Galatians 5:22-23).

For the Jewish World

- Thank God the Father that He will gather the Jews from among the nations **for His name's sake and that He will sanctify them** (Ezekiel 37:21-28).
- Pray for the **traditional Jewish communities in your city and nation** to know the Holy Spirit as a Person - *a very present and living Comforter, Counsellor, Helper, Advocate, Intercessor, Strengtheners and Standby* (John 16:7, AMP).



DAY 5: 3 JUNE 2025

RECONCILIATION

For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation... (Ephesians 2:14).

Scripture Reading: Ephesians 2:11-18

Let us pray

For the Church

- Praise God for **the work of reconciliation on the Cross**, and that every individual can be reconciled to God through the Blood of Jesus.
- Pray that the **spiritual leaders of your local church** will actively **share the message of forgiveness and reconciliation with families** in your community who are hurting or experiencing broken relationships.

For the Jewish World

- Pray for all **obstacles that hinder love and unity between Jewish and Gentile believers** to be removed.
- Pray for the **salvation of Jewish unbelievers**; for them to believe that they have access to God through the shed Blood of Jesus (Ephesians 2:13).



DAY 6: 4 JUNE 2025

GODLY ATTITUDE

... be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous; not returning evil for evil... (1 Peter 3:8-9a).

Scripture reading: 1 Peter 3:8-12

Let us pray

For the Church

- Ask the Holy Spirit to help the Body of Christ **willingly submit to His sanctifying work**, producing spiritual fruit.
- Confess any works and acts to gain righteousness imposed **by religion and the fear of man** in the Church.

For the Jewish World

- Bring the hearts of Jewish people before the Lord, **to remain soft and tender towards the Lord** when they are ridiculed, excluded or mistreated.
- Pray for them to grow in the knowledge of God's love for them, understanding that God the Father **demonstrated His love through the death of Jesus Christ** (Romans 5:8).



DAY 7: 5 JUNE 2025

REPENTANCE

I thought about my ways, and turned my feet to Your testimonies. (Psalm 119:59).

Scripture reading: Psalm 51

Let us pray

For the Church

- Pray for believers to pause daily and reflect on their thoughts, words, and actions, measuring them against the truth of God's Word and making necessary corrections.
- Confess the sin of the Body of Christ for **compromising the Word of God**.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to help believers discern between **truth and being culturally relevant**.

For the Jewish World

- Pray for **believers in Israel to know God's will and to be filled with His truth** and wisdom so they can live lives worthy of Him, bearing good fruit (Colossians 1:10).
- Pray that the veil over their minds and hearts will be **removed through the reading of Scripture**; that deceptions will be exposed and the ignorant be enlightened (John 8:32).



DAY 8: 6 JUNE 2025

RESTORATION

The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me... (Luke 4:18a).

Scripture reading: Luke 4:16-21

Let us pray

For the Church

- Praise Jesus that He has set the example for the Church and that all believers **in Him can restore justice in their sphere of influence**.
- Pray for the Church to **confess her apathy toward justice issues** and to be inspired to reach out and bear spiritual fruit as she yields to the Spirit of God.

For the Jewish World

- Pray for Jews who suffer injustice to call on God in prayer, for **He promises to avenge those who call out to Him night and day** (Luke 18:6, Hebrews 10:30).
- Pray for Jews to love their enemies, bless those who curse them, do good to those who hate them, and pray for those who spitefully use and persecute them (Matthew 5:44).



DAY 9: 7 JUNE 2025

DAILY WALK WITH GOD

One thing I have desired of the Lord, that will I seek: That I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the Lord, and to inquire in His temple. (Psalm 27:4).

Scripture reading: Luke 10:38-42

Let us pray

For the Church

- Pray for spiritual leaders to encourage children and youth to **engage in daily Bible study and listening for God's voice.**
- Also pray that church activities and programmes will **not replace corporate times of waiting on God and seeking Him in prayer and worship.**

For the Jewish World

- Pray for a **yearning for the Lord, the fountain of living waters**, in the spirits of Jewish people (Jeremiah 2:13, John 7:38).
- Ask the Holy Spirit to convict Jews to seek God deeply—that He would become their greatest desire and the one pursuit they value above all else.



DAY 10: 8 JUNE 2025

WATCHMEN FOR JERUSALEM

I have set watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; they shall never hold their peace day or night. (Isaiah 62:6a).

Scripture reading: Isaiah 62:1-7

Let us pray

For the Church

- Pray for your local church to confess **prayerlessness and unbelief.**
- Pray for believers **to seek God with commitment** in personal prayer, fellowship, and fasting—asking for His healing in your nation (2 Chronicles 7:14).

For the Jewish World

- Pray that the global Church will pray compassionately and earnestly for Jerusalem to accept Jesus as the Messiah (Luke 19:41).
- Pray for watchmen on the wall in Jerusalem who will stand in the gap for her spiritual restoration.
- Pray for Jerusalem to be restored to righteousness, shining with glory as a praise on the earth.
- Pray for healing and unity between Jewish and Arab believers in Israel.
