24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL 1-7 September 2025

Since the 1990s, God, by His Spirit, has stirred a global movement of 24-7 prayer watches. What began with just a few dozen has grown into thousands since the year 2000. These watches mobilise churches, regions and nations to seek God's face day and night—raising up watchmen devoted to praise, worship, and intercession at His throne of grace.

This week, we celebrate what God has done! We continue to A-S-K (ask, seek and knock) and declare, 'Your Kingdom come!'

MONDAY 1 SEPTEMBER 2025

SPIRITUAL AWAKENING

AFTER THIS I WILL RETURN AND WILL REBUILD THE TABERNACLE OF DAVID,...SO THAT THE REST OF MANKIND MAY SEEK THE LORD, EVEN ALL THE GENTILES... (Acts 15:16-17).

Also read: Mark 11:17, Acts 15:16-17

The Church, through prayer and worship, will draw all nations into His Kingdom (Mark 11:17). The [7 Days on the Wall](#) initiative, launched in 2012, already unites 40 nations in annual 24-7 prayer for global revival.

Consider: Encouraging your congregation to engage in this revival-focused prayer initiative.

Let us pray

- Give thanks to God for this prayer initiative, along with the testimonies and spiritual growth it has produced.
 - Ask the Lord to bring salvation to the nations as people call out for revival (Psalm 2:8).
 - Pray for a spirit of repentance to fall afresh upon us as the Church (Psalm. 24:3-4).
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TUESDAY 2 SEPTEMBER 2025

GOD OF JUSTICE

And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him...? (Luke 18:7).

Also read: Luke 18:1-8

Widows often face discrimination, poverty and stigma, leaving them and their children vulnerable, with youth often drifting into rebellion.

In 2001, a pastor's wife in Pretoria began monthly all-night prayers for her addicted son and others like him; by 2006, it grew to 288 groups nationwide.

Consider: How can you join or help mobilise a prayer watch with a strategic focus on **injustice**?

Let us pray

- Give thanks to God for encouraging believers facing hardships to place their full trust in Him and find victory, peace and love.
- Pray for governmental laws that protect widows and safeguard their rights, ensuring their dignity and well-being.
- Ask God to defend widows in court and for lawyers and judges to uphold integrity, fairness and justice (Psalm 68:5).

WEDNESDAY 3 SEPTEMBER 2025

WATCHMEN ON THE WALL

I have set watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; they shall never hold their peace day or night. (Isaiah 62:6a).

Also read: Isaiah 62:1-7

Since the year 2000 the number 24-7 prayer watches has grown exponentially.

[Succat Hallel](#), a 24-7 Jerusalem house of prayer, has dedicated 19 years to worship, intercession, training Christians and fostering reconciliation across diverse communities, especially praying for Israel.

Consider: [Establishing a 24-7 prayer watch](#) in your community/city.

Let us pray

- Pray for city watchmen to remain steadfast in prayer, giving God no rest.
- Ask the Spirit to keep them watchful, wise and diligent before God (Ephesians 1:17-18; Colossians 4:2).
- Praise God for established prayer ministries and thank Him for the spiritual fruit of their labour.

THURSDAY 4 SEPTEMBER 2025

CONTINUED DEVOTION

A fire shall always be burning on the altar; it shall never go out. (Leviticus 6:13).

Also read: Leviticus 6:12-13

Priests' main tasks according to the Old Testament were intercession and worship, with the altar's fire that symbolised their continual prayer, praise and reconciliation.

In 1727, the Moravians of Herrnhut began a 24-7 prayer watch lasting 125 years. Starting with 48 believers, it spread to youth and children, fuelling revival, global missions, new churches worldwide and influencing the origin of the Methodist Church.

Consider: Initiating a prayer group at your local congregation.

Let us pray

- Pray that no believer will neglect their priestly position before God, but will behold Him in the beauty of His sanctuary and see His power and glory (Psalm 63:1-2).
- By name, pray for the spiritual leaders in your community to remain diligent in prayer – in secret and corporate times of prayer.
- Thank God for the example of continued prayer by the Moravians and what future generations can learn from it.

FRIDAY 5 SEPTEMBER 2025

LET YOUR KINGDOM COME

The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!" (Revelation 4:8).

Also read: Revelation 4 and 5

The 24 elders and living creatures worship God day and night. Jesus taught us to pray for His will to be done on earth as in heaven. Since heaven overflows with praise, worship and intercession, we long for earth to echo with continual exaltation too.

Maranatha Prayer Network in Mitchell's Plain, South Africa, began in 2017 by partnering with local congregations to teach on prayer. They launched prayer initiatives, navigated the 2020 Covid-19 lockdown, expanded through camps and schools, grew women's prayer networks and are now building a 24-7 prayer missionary house in Mitchell's Plain. Consider: Arrange street or marketplace worship with Christ-centred music to draw people to God's presence.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Kingdom of God will come in your nation, government and city.
- Thank Him that *"Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end"* (Isaiah 9:7).
- Pray for the establishment of prayer networks in your city through teaching, unity and prayer initiatives fostered by the united work of local congregations.

SATURDAY 6 SEPTEMBER 2025

PRAYERS FOR YOUTH

Pour out your heart like water before the face of the Lord. Lift your hands toward Him for the life of your young children... (Lamentations 2:19).

Also read: Lamentations 2:18-19

Jesus instructed that children should not be kept from knowing Him (Mark 10:14). Currently, 2 billion children under the age of 15 worldwide can be brought to Jesus in prayer!

In Ukraine, a group of believers gathered for 50 hours of continuous prayer amidst the war (July 2025). Even when the city, Lviv, came under heavy attack on the second night, they experienced God's unshakable peace as they prayed.

Consider: Set up a creative prayer space that remains accessible for young people, allowing them to experience God's presence firsthand.

Let us pray

- Pray for this generation of young people to return to God; to become God-fearing men and women who will live according to God's will and purpose.
- According to God's Word, declare that they will be filled with God's Spirit accompanied by prophecy and visions (Joel 2:28).

SUNDAY 7 SEPTEMBER 2025

PRAYERS FOR THE CHURCH

For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding... (Colossians 1:9).

Also read: Colossians 1:9-12, Ephesians 1: 15-23

Throughout his letters, the apostle Paul frequently refers to his ongoing intercession for the Church. In John 17, Jesus prayed for His disciples and all future believers. Persistent prayer remains essential for the Church's growth and strength.

Community transformation started in Whatcom County, Washington State USA with a 3-fold prayer strategy:

- 30 Churches take a day of prayer once a month
- Strategic prayer in the seven spheres of society
- Sharing a prayer guide with praise reports

Let us pray

- Praise God for answered prayers in your community and nation.
- Pray for unity among congregations in towns and cities in seeking God for a prayer strategy that brings transformation (2 Chronicles 7:14).
