This longing is not a passive emotion but an active, transformative force – the compelling of God's love that spurs believers to seek God's truth, live according to His commandments and work tirelessly to advance His Kingdom on earth.

For the next week, pray not only for yourself, but also for your community, your city and nation, and for every people group and place, that God's Kingdom will come and His will be done on earth as in heaven.

MONDAY 22 SEPTEMBER 2025

HUMBLE YOURSELF

Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord and He will lift you up. (James 4:10).

Additional reading: 1 Peter 5:5-6

Let us pray

Search me, O God and know my heart; try me and know my anxieties; and see if there is any wicked way in me and lead me in the way everlasting. (Psalm 139:23-24).

Wait in silence

Take 5–10 minutes to wait quietly before the Holy Spirit.

Personal prayer

- Seek the Lord's forgiveness for selfishness, idolatry, or self-exaltation.
- Ask the Lord to help you forgive someone who has harmed you.
- Be willing to reach out and apologise to someone you have hurt.

Intercession

- Pray for people in **your city and nation** to humble themselves before God (2 Chronicles 7:14).
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TUESDAY 23 SEPTEMBER 2025

GROW TO SPIRITUAL MATURITY

Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection... (Hebrews 6:1a).

Additional reading: Hebrews 6:1-2; Colossians 1:9-10

Let us pray

Abide in Me and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me. (John 15:4).

Wait in silence

Take 5–10 minutes to wait quietly before the Holy Spirit.

Personal prayer

- Speak to the Holy Spirit about the spiritual fruit in your life.
- Ask the Lord what steps you need to take toward greater maturity in your walk with Jesus and write out your plan to follow them.

Intercession

- Pray for **leaders in your city to mentor** and prepare future church leaders, entrusting them with the vision to establish and multiply disciple-making fellowships.
 - Pray for God's wisdom, courage, faith, protection and perseverance as **leaders in persecuted nations** devote their lives to sharing the Gospel.
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WEDNESDAY 24 SEPTEMBER 2025

YES AND AMEN

For all the promises of God in Him are Yes and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us. (2 Corinthians 1:20)

Additional reading: Isaiah 55:8-11; 2 Corinthians 1:18-20

Let us pray

Remember the word to Your servant, upon which You have caused me to hope. This is my comfort in my affliction, for Your word has given me life. (Psalm 119:49-50).

Wait in silence

Take 5–10 minutes to wait quietly before the Holy Spirit.

Personal prayer

- Bring your prayer concerns before the Lord, asking Him to guide and comfort you through His Word.
- Revisit promises of God by praying through them for yourself, family relationships and wider community.

Intercession

- Pray for every Jesus follower to live in light of the hope of the Gospel despite suffering.
- Pray for nations that the Holy Spirit reminds you of to be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord as the waters cover the sea (Habakkuk 2:14).

THURSDAY 25 SEPTEMBER 2025

PARTNER WITH GOD

... it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure. (Philippians 2:13).

Additional reading: 1 Corinthians 3:4-11, Philippians 2:12-13

Let us pray

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light...(1 Peter 2:9).

Wait in silence

Take 5–10 minutes to wait quietly before the Holy Spirit.

Personal prayer

- Seek the Lord's forgiveness for any failure to listen to Him and partner with Him in His kingdom.
- Ask the Lord for help to give as you have received from Him – resources, time, talents, etc.
- Praise God for calling You and ask His guidance to accomplish what He has assigned to you.

Intercession

- Pray for believers to faithfully follow the example of leaders and mentors who demonstrate faith and perseverance in Christ (Hebrews 6:10–12).
- Pray that the Church will show generosity to impoverished communities, resist corruption and distribute resources with fairness, integrity and transparency.

FRIDAY 26 SEPTEMBER 2025

PLENTIFUL HARVEST

... pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. (Matthew 9:38).

Additional reading: Matthew 9:37-38; 2 Peter 3:9; 2 Corinthians 5:14-15

Let us pray

I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: "Whom shall I send and who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me." (Isaiah 6:8).

Wait in silence

Take 5–10 minutes to wait quietly before the Holy Spirit.

Personal prayer

- Ask the Lord's forgiveness for moments you shrank back from sharing His good news.
- Implore the Lord to open your eyes to see the opportunities to share the Gospel.

Intercession

- Pray for all people groups in the **major cities of your nation** to come to the full knowledge of God and Jesus Christ, whom He has sent.
 - Pray for unity in the Church to carry the message of salvation far and near, being disciples and becoming effective disciple-makers.
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SATURDAY 27 SEPTEMBER 2025

NONE WOULD PERISH

The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. (2 Peter 3:9).

Additional reading: Luke 15:4; Luke 19:10; John 3:16

Let us pray

Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance? (Romans 2:4).

Wait in silence

Take 5–10 minutes to wait quietly before the Holy Spirit.

Personal prayer

- In humility of heart, bow before the Lord, asking for revelation of the great price He was willing to pay for the salvation of the world.
- Pray sincerely about your own salvation and His longing to work through you to reach other souls for Him.

Intercession

- Ask God for names of **people in your sphere of influence who do not yet follow Jesus**; record their names and pray for them regularly, looking for opportunities to share the Gospel.
 - Pray for people groups in your country who are resistant to the Gospel, ask the Lord for an open door to reach them with the Gospel of salvation.
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SUNDAY 28 SEPTEMBER 2025

RETURN OF THE KING

Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. (Matthew 24:30).

Additional reading: Luke 19:11-27

Let us pray

For the LORD is a God of justice; blessed are all those who wait for Him. (Isaiah 30:18).

Wait in silence

Take 5–10 minutes to wait quietly before the Holy Spirit.

Personal prayer

- In worship and adoration, speak to the Lord about His return and how you long for Him. Proclaim His coming, His rule and reign and your anticipation to stand before Him face to face.

Intercession

- Pray for the justice system in your country, praying for the different institutions enforcing law and justice.
 - Pray for God to establish His justice in your nation and to prepare every heart for the return of the King.
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
