MONDAY 27 OCTOBER 2025 THE TESTIMONY OF THE LORD

The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. (Psalm 19:7b).

God's Word is His faithful witness, a testimony that cannot be shaken. It declares His nature, His works and His promises. His testimony brings certainty and wisdom to those who receive it with childlike faith. Just as Israel trusted God's testimony in the wilderness (Deuteronomy 8:3), today His Word still anchors hearts in truth.

Let us pray

- Thank the Lord that His testimony is sure; ask Him to make it a light to the simple and wisdom to the lost (Psalm 119:105).
- Ask the Lord to cause people everywhere to receive His Word as reliable truth, unchanging and eternal (Matthew 24:35).

TUESDAY 28 OCTOBER 2025

THE STATUTES OF THE LORD

The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart. (Psalm 19:8a).

God's statutes are His decrees for holy living. Unlike the shifting morals of culture, His Word stands as the righteous path. Obedience brings joy, not bondage, because His ways lead to life and peace. David declared, *Your testimonies I have taken as a heritage forever, for they are the rejoicing of my heart* (Psalm 119:111).

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to cause His people to delight in His statutes, rejoicing in obedience and walking in the freedom from sin (Romans 6:17-18).
- Ask the Father to restore to this generation the joy of living by His Word, so that their hearts may rejoice in His truth (Psalm 119:162).

WEDNESDAY 29 OCTOBER 2025

THE COMMANDMENT OF THE LORD

The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. (Psalm 19:8b).

God's commandments reveal His holiness and purity. Unlike man-made rules, they are perfect and radiant, bringing light to blind eyes. They uncover hidden sins and teach discernment. *For the commandment is a lamp and the law a light...* (Proverbs 6:23). His pure commandments open our eyes to truth, purity and His direction.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to open the eyes of His people through the purity of His commandments, allowing light to shine in every place of spiritual blindness (Psalm 119:105).
- Pray that the Father will cleanse hearts through obedience to His Word, so His people may walk as children of light in a dark generation (Ephesians 5:8-9).

THURSDAY 30 OCTOBER 2025

THE FEAR OF THE LORD

The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever... (Psalm 19:9a).

The fear of the Lord is holy reverence, awe and submission to His holiness. Unlike the fear of man, which corrupts the heart with selfish motives, the fear of the Lord cleanses the heart and produces pure intentions that honour God. *The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom...* (Proverbs 9:10).

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will restore the fear of the Lord to His people, cleansing the Church from compromise and producing wisdom that endures (Proverbs 14:27).
- Ask the Father to deliver the youth from the fear of man's opinions and teach them to stand in awe of Him alone, walking in holiness (Isaiah 33:6).

FRIDAY 31 OCTOBER 2025

THE WORD OF THE LORD BRINGS JOY

The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart. (Psalm 19:8a).

God's Word is a fountain of joy and not a burden. His commands bring life, freedom and lasting gladness. The psalmist declared he found greater joy in God's Word than in riches (Psalm 119:14). True joy flows from obedience, renewing hearts, restoring hope and strengthening believers in times of trial.

Let us pray

- Thank the Lord for His Word that brings joy to the heart; ask Him to fill His people with gladness in obedience and with freedom in Christ (John 15:11).
- Ask the Lord to cause believers worldwide to hunger daily for the Word of God, finding strength, hope and joy that no trial can remove (Nehemiah 8:10).

SATURDAY 1 NOVEMBER 2025

THE BLOOD OF JESUS

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace. (Ephesians 1:7).

At the centre of God's Word is the redeeming power of the blood of Jesus. His blood washes away sin, reconciles us to God and gives victory over the enemy. How much more shall the blood of Christ... cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? (Hebrews 9:14). Throughout history, revival has come through prayer, repentance and the bold proclamation of the cross and blood of Jesus.

Let us pray

- Thank the Lord for the blood of Jesus that redeems and forgives; ask Him to cover this generation in His cleansing power and awaken them to repentance and new life (1 John 1:7).
- Ask the Father to raise intercessors who will prevail in prayer, silence the enemy's accusations and release revival through the proclamation of the cross (Revelation 12:11).

SUNDAY 2 NOVEMBER 2025

THE WORD OF GOD

For the word of God is living and powerful and sharper than any two-edged sword... (Hebrews 4:12).

The Word of God is alive, powerful and eternal. It convicts, corrects, heals and equips believers for every good work (2 Timothy 3:16-17). Nations rise and fall, but God's Word endures forever (Isaiah 40:8). When spoken in faith, His Word breaks chains, pierces hearts and transforms lives.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to let His Word run swiftly across the earth, bringing revival, salvation and transformation (2 Thessalonians 3:1).
- Pray that the Father will write His Word on the hearts of believers, so they may shine as living testimonies of Christ (Jeremiah 31:33).
