24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL

22-28 December 2025

We are about to enter a new year and pray that the reign of Christ will be revealed in every heart and nation. Revival does not only mean renewal, but also a deeper commitment to prayer and discipleship.

In this first part of a three-part series, '*Proclaim the Saviour*', we pray that God's Kingdom will be established in the hearts of believers and that the reason for His coming will be proclaimed.

MONDAY 22 DECEMBER 2025

THE LIGHT HAS COME

That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world. (John 1:9-12).

The Lord Jesus, the true Light, revealed the Father's glory and truth with His coming. His coming overcomes spiritual blindness and gives all who believe in Him the right to become God's children.

Let us pray

- Lord Jesus, You are the Light that no darkness can overcome; shine through Your Church again (John 8:12).
- Pray that the Father will drive out spiritual blindness and open the hearts of people to receive the Light of Christ (2 Corinthians 4:6).
- Ask the Holy Spirit to ignite a fire of purity and truth that draws nations to Him (Isaiah 60:1-3).

TUESDAY 23 DECEMBER 2025

THE WORD BECAME FLESH

And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us... (John 1:14a).

The mystery of Jesus is that God became a real, tangible, living person, Jesus Christ, who walked the Earth to live among humanity, reveal God's character and provide redemption.

Let us pray

- Ask the Father to let His Word dwell richly within us so that Christ may be seen in our lives (Colossians 3:16).
- Pray that Jesus will give us boldness to be living testimonies of His grace and truth wherever we go (John 1:14).
- Ask the Holy Spirit to manifest the presence of Christ through love, humility and compassion for our brothers and sisters in Jesus (Philippians 2:5-8).

WEDNESDAY 24 DECEMBER 2025

THE LAMB OF GOD

The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (John 1:29).

John the Baptist's proclamation, "Behold, the Lamb of God," revealed Jesus as the One who would take away the sin of the world.

Let us pray

- Praise the Lord Jesus, who bore our sin and shame on the cross (Isaiah 53:4-5).
- Pray that the Lord will purify His Church from compromise and restore the cross to the centre of her message (1 Corinthians 1:18).
- Ask the Holy Spirit to convict people's hearts of sin and awaken a fresh cry for holiness and purity (John 16:8).

THURSDAY 25 DECEMBER 2025

THE GOOD SHEPHERD

"I am the good shepherd..." (John 10:11-14).

Jesus came not only to teach, but to be a shepherd, to guide, to protect and to lay down His life for His sheep. He knows each one by name and leads them with His unfailing love.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will restore our compassion for the wandering and broken and make us shepherds after His heart (Jeremiah 3:15).
- Ask God to bring those who have strayed back to Him and to care for them and heal their wounded hearts (Ezekiel 34:11-12).
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will awaken leaders to serve sacrificially with the love of Christ (1 Peter 5:2-4).

FRIDAY 26 DECEMBER 2025

THE SAVIOUR OF THE WORLD

"...we ourselves have heard Him and we know that this is indeed the Christ, the Savior of the world." (John 4:39-42).

Jesus did not come for one nation but for all people. As the Saviour of the world, He breaks barriers of sin, culture and distance, offering living water to every thirsty soul.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord Jesus to awaken a testimony in people's hearts that points others to Him (Psalm 107:2).
- Pray that the Lord will use their stories to reveal His power to save (Mark 5:19).
- Ask the Holy Spirit to empower believers to share the truth in love and lead many to Christ (Acts 1:8).

SATURDAY 27 DECEMBER 2025

THE PRINCE OF PEACE

...And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace... (Isaiah 9:6-7).

Jesus, the Prince of Peace, came to still the storms within people's hearts and to restore their broken fellowship with God. His peace reaches deeper than outward calm; it heals wounds, reconciles relationships and restores hope.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord Jesus will reign as Prince of Peace over hearts, families and nations (John 14:27).
- Ask the Lord to heal divisions in the Body of Christ and to unite her in love (Colossians 3:14-15).
- Pray that God's peace, which surpasses all understanding, will guard every heart and mind through Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:7).

SUNDAY 28 DECEMBER 2025

THE KING OF GLORY

...Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, The LORD mighty in battle... (Psalm 24:7-10).

The first coming of Christ revealed a humble King, clothed with mercy and grace; His return will unveil the King of Glory, clothed with power and splendour. He comes to reign in righteousness, to overthrow darkness and to fill the earth with the radiance of His presence.

Let us pray

- Pray that King Jesus will be exalted in His Church and throughout our generation (Revelation 5:12).
 - Ask the Lord to open ancient gates of pride and unbelief so that the King of Glory may come in (Psalm 24:7-10).
 - Pray that the Holy Spirit will fill the earth with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD (Habakkuk 2:14).
