24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL

29 DECEMBER - 4 JANUARY 2026

Jesus came to establish His Kingdom and the Kingdom is built on Christ, the chosen cornerstone. In the second part of a three-part series, 'Proclaim the Saviour', we pray that His unshakable Kingdom will be established in us, through us and around us, until the whole earth is filled with the glory of His reign.

MONDAY 29 DECEMBER 2025

THE KINGDOM BEGINS WITH THE KING

...the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David..." (Luke 1:32-33).

Every kingdom begins with a king. Jesus, the Son of God, was born to rule and His Kingdom is established and maintained by His absolute power, righteousness and eternal dominion, not by the authority of earthly leaders.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord Jesus to help people hear His voice, open their hearts and enthrone Him as Lord over their lives (Revelation 3:20).
- Pray that nations will recognise that true leadership flows from His lordship (Psalm 2:8).
- Ask the Lord to establish His Kingdom where people's hearts welcome His authority (Matthew 21:5).

TUESDAY 30 DECEMBER 2025

THE KINGDOM IS BUILT ON THE WORD

"Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine and does them..." (Matthew 7:24-25).

The Kingdom of God is built on His unchanging promises and faithfulness. It advances as people receive the Gospel, align their lives with His Word and when believers walk in obedience, reflecting His righteousness and proclaiming His truth through both their words and deeds.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to make His Word the cornerstone of believers' lives and ministries (Psalm 119:105).
- Pray that the Lord will uproot false teaching and compromise that weaken the Church (2 Timothy 4:2-3).
- Ask the Lord to establish a hunger for Scripture that leads to obedience and transformation (Joshua 1:8).

WEDNESDAY 31 DECEMBER 2025

THE KINGDOM ADVANCES THROUGH THE SPIRIT

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you...." (Acts 1:8).

God's Kingdom grows and spreads through the transformative, internal work of the Holy Spirit. This spiritual power enables believers to live out their faith, impacting the world around them.

Let us pray

- Ask the Holy Spirit to fill us afresh to be witnesses of Christ everywhere (Acts 2:4).
- Pray for hearts that are sensitive to the Holy Spirit's leading, so His voice guides every word, action and decision in advancing His Kingdom (Romans 8:14)
- Ask the Lord to empower the Church to live boldly and compassionately in truth (Zechariah 4:6).

THURSDAY 1 JANUARY 2026

THE KINGDOM IS REVEALED THROUGH LOVE

"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another..." (John 13:34-35).

The greatest distinction of Jesus' Kingdom is His sacrificial, forgiving and enduring love. This love reflects His heart, heals broken relationships, restores unity and reveals the transforming power of His reign.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to teach us to love as He loves, without prejudice or pride (1 Corinthians 13:4-7).
- Pray that the Lord will heal divisions within families, churches and nations (Colossians 3:14).
- Ask that the love of the Lord within us become a light that draws people to Christ (Romans 5:5).

FRIDAY 2 JANUARY 2026

THE KINGDOM GROWS THROUGH SERVICE

"...For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve...." (Mark 10:43-45).

Jesus established His Kingdom through service. True greatness is characterised by humility, compassion and selfless love. He showed that true leadership lifts others up, does not lord over them and flows from a heart surrendered to God.

Let us pray

- Ask that the Lord will give us servant hearts that mirror His (Philippians 2:5-7).
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will teach us to serve with joy and reflect Christ's humility and love (John 13:14-15).
- Ask the Lord to let the Church be known for her sacrificial service that glorifies Him (Matthew 25:40).

SATURDAY 3 JANUARY 2026

THE KINGDOM ADVANCES THROUGH PRAYER AND OBEDIENCE

"Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:10).

God's reign extends on earth through believers who pray and obey. Prayer aligns hearts with His purpose and obedience demonstrates faith through daily good deeds that practically reveal His Kingdom.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to align our desires with His so His will be done in every decision (John 14:23).
 - Pray that the Lord will raise up intercessors who will pray for the salvation and revival of the nations (Ezekiel 22:30).
 - Ask the Lord for strength to obey His will above comfort, trust His wisdom and find joy in full surrender (Isaiah 55:9).
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SUNDAY 4 JANUARY 2026

THE KINGDOM IS ESTABLISHED THROUGH THE CROSS

He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins. (Colossians 1:13-14).

The cross is the foundation of the Kingdom. Through His sacrifice, Jesus conquered sin, conquered darkness and transferred us who believe in Him into His Kingdom of light.

Let us pray

- Give thanks to the Lord for the victory of the cross that secures our redemption (Revelation 5:9-10).
 - Pray that the message of the cross will be preached with conviction and compassion (1 Corinthians 1:18).
 - Pray that believers will walk daily in the power of Christ's resurrection, revealing His Kingdom through renewed, obedient lives (Romans 6:4).
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
