24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL 1-7 DECEMBER 2025

Throughout the Bible, God invites us to draw near to Him. This invitation flows from His everlasting love. In a world constantly competing for our attention, we are called to respond to His loving call.

As we begin the first week of our three-week series, 'Focus on Family', we encourage you and your household to accept God's invitation to spend time in His presence. We trust God to unite families in His love and to draw them into a deeper relationship with Himself.

MONDAY 1 DECEMBER 2025

DRAW NEAR TO ME

Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. (James 4:8a).

Let us pray

- Bring your **hands and heart before the Lord in prayer** as you wait on the Holy Spirit to speak to you. Allow Him to convict you of anything that needs to be made right (James 4:8b).
- Pray for **unbelievers in your own household and among your** neighbours – that hearts will turn to God, that the double-minded will seek His wisdom and that the power of Jesus' blood will bring healing to those burdened by past sins.

Consider: Set aside time today for your household to meet together. Listen to your favourite worship song(s) and read Scriptures of worship and adoration aloud, e.g. Revelation 15:3-4.

TUESDAY 2 DECEMBER 2025

CAST YOUR BURDENS ON HIM

Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden and I will give you rest. (Matthew 11:28).

Let us pray

- Take a few moments to reflect on the Lord's goodness and praise Him for who He is.
- Confess any self-reliant attitude in your home and bring burdens from unwise choices to the Lord, asking for His wisdom and help.
- Pray for the **breadwinner(s) in your household and city** to cast every difficulty on Him (1 Peter 5:7).

Consider: Gather as a family, share your challenges, pray together, encourage one another with God's Word and seek His guidance to support each other in love.

WEDNESDAY 3 DECEMBER 2025

GOD WELCOMES OUR QUESTIONS

"Come now and let us reason together," says the LORD... (Isaiah 1:18a).

Let us pray

- Thank God for His constant presence and wisdom.
- **Entrust every challenging family matter to God**, approaching Him in humility, sincerity and a willingness to align with His truth.
- Pray for the **youth in your extended family and nation** to reason with God about the daily issues that affect their generation.

Consider: Encourage your household to write down difficult questions and place them in a jar. Set aside time to discuss them together, pray and search the Bible for God's perspective.

THURSDAY 4 DECEMBER 2025

DINING WITH THE KING

Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him and he with Me. (Revelation 3:20).

Let us pray

- Thank Jesus for His patience and grace toward you, for continually pursuing you and knocking on the door of your heart.
- Take time today to truly dine with the Lord – to linger in His presence without hurry, seeking His face.
- Pray for **prodigal family members** to hear and respond to the Lord's voice, opening their hearts to Him in worship and devotion.

Consider: Read Revelation 3:14-22 together as a household. Seek Jesus together in repentant prayer and ask Him to keep your hearts ablaze for Him.

FRIDAY 5 DECEMBER 2025

BOW BEFORE YOUR MAKER

Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the LORD our Maker. (Psalm 95:6).

Let us pray

- **Worship and praise God** by praying Psalms 95–100 out loud. Reflect on the words and phrases that stand out to you as you honour Him in worship.
- Pray that the **identity of young children will be deeply rooted in the Lord their Maker**, in who He created them to be.
- Pray for the grandchildren in your extended family by name, asking the Lord to draw them by His Spirit to worship Him in spirit and in truth.

Consider: Encourage each member of your household, both young and old, to bow before the Lord – whether in personal prayer or during a shared time of family worship.

SATURDAY 6 DECEMBER 2025

JESUS LOVES CHILDREN

But Jesus said, "Let the little children come to Me and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 19:14).

Let us pray

- Pray for the **children in your household and extended family**. Bring any hardship, sickness or fear before the Lord in prayer, asking Him to deliver and heal them.
- Pray for their salvation – that each child will come **to know their need for the Saviour and surrender their hearts to Him**.
- Pray for **families with adopted or foster children**, that these children may experience the love of Jesus through the care and compassion of their parents and guardians.

Consider: Pray Numbers 6:24-26 as a prayer of blessing over the children in your family.

SUNDAY 7 DECEMBER 2025

DEVOTED TO JESUS

"Whoever desires to come after Me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me." (Mark 8:34).

Let us pray

- **Thank Jesus** for carrying the cross in perfect obedience to the Father and for taking upon Himself the sin of the world – including your own.
- **Be still before God** and let Him reveal desires or pursuits keeping you from complete surrender.
- Pray that every member of your family **will seek the Lord daily and live as a living sacrifice** for His glory.

Consider: Encourage your family to reflect on what it truly means to deny oneself to follow Jesus. Talk about how this can be practically lived out in everyday interactions with one another.
