24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL 15-21 DECEMBER 2025

We all know someone in our family who has not been reconciled to God the Father through His Son, Jesus Christ. God wants to save them and can save them. However, it is also the will of God that we should pray for their salvation.

In this final week of our series, 'Focus on Family', join us in praying for the salvation of families.

MONDAY 15 DECEMBER 2025 SALVATION OF YOUNG CHILDREN

"Let the little children come to Me, and do not forbid them; for of such is the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 19:14).

Pray the Word: Psalm 8:2; Isaiah 54:13

Let us pray

- Pray for the **salvation of young children** in your extended family.
- In like manner as Eli directed Samuel to respond to the Lord's voice when He spoke, pray for parents to discern when the Lord is speaking to their children.

TESTIMONY

After hearing the story of Zacchaeus, a family of six in the Himalayas accepted Christ. Maya, a seven-year-old family member, was inspired to share the story. She told sixty school friends as well as her teachers. Her bold witness and childlike faith led to one friend's salvation and many hearing the gospel.

TUESDAY 16 DECEMBER 2025

SALVATION OF FATHERS

"Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved, you and your household." (Acts 16:31).

Pray the Word: John 16:8-11; Revelation 3:20

Let us pray

- Ask the **Holy Spirit to convince dads** of who God the Father is and Jesus Christ, whom He has sent.
- Pray for their **relationships with Christ to have a lasting impact on their family relationships**; for the hearts of the fathers to turn to their children.

TESTIMONY

"A miracle happened! My husband heard God's voice," exclaimed the Syrian Muslim. One morning after coffee, Delavan saw a bright light enter through his window and into his heart. Hearing Jesus say, "I am Jesus Christ," he felt transformed – his old self died and a new life in Christ began within him.

WEDNESDAY 17 DECEMBER 2025

REACHING UNEVANGELISED FAMILIES

...you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart. (Jeremiah 29:13).

Pray the Word: Isaiah 65:1; Romans 10:13

Let us pray

- Cry out to God for the salvation of **families living in areas with no Christian exposure**.
- Ask that **Christian literature** be made available in their own language.
- Pray for God to send someone who will share the **Gospel with them clearly and truthfully**.

TESTIMONY

As a child in Egypt, Reem longed to enter a nearby church but was not allowed. Later in Libya, she questioned her family's beliefs, searched online and discovered in Jesus the loving, forgiving God she had always been seeking.

THURSDAY 18 DECEMBER 2025

SALVATION OF TROUBLED YOUTH

For You are my hope, O Lord GOD; You are my trust from my youth. (Psalm 71:5).

Pray the Word: Psalm 71:5-8; Luke 15:1-7,11-32

Let us pray

- Pray for **troubled youth to turn to God's Word** and prayer when overwhelmed by sin and the pressures of the world.
- Ask the Lord to **deliver them from escapism** in the form of substance abuse, self-harm or social media distractions
- **Declare the power of Jesus's Blood** to deliver, redeem, sanctify and cleanse their lives completely.

TESTIMONY

At 13, Kari's life collapsed after her parents faced divorce. Overwhelmed and suicidal, she read Psalms 22-27 and encountered the Lord, who transformed her despair into hope and gave her a new, life-changing relationship with Him.

FRIDAY 19 DECEMBER 2025

PRAYING FOR TRAUMATISED HEARTS

In the multitude of my anxieties within me, Your comforts delight my soul. (Psalm 94:19).

Pray the Word: 2 Corinthians 1:3-5

Let us pray

- Pray for **mothers who have hardened their hearts towards God because of hardship**, trauma or grief.
- **Pray the attributes of God**, *The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in mercy* (Psalm 103:8), over their lives.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to comfort them in their distress and help them to respond to God's tender voice of love and compassion in repentance.

TESTIMONY

After her son's sudden death, an Egyptian mother rebelled against God in deep grief. One night, Jesus appeared to her in a dream, and she was taken to church. She felt revived, returned to worship, and experienced a profound transformation in her faith and life.

SATURDAY 20 DECEMBER 2025

GOD'S WORD RESTORES LIVES

The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul... (Psalm 19:7).

Pray the Word: Psalm 19:7-11; Acts 8:26-40

Let us pray

- Pray for **unbelieving extended family members** to be drawn to read and study the Word of God.
- Ask the Lord to send His servants to proclaim His Word so that many may respond **in repentance, be saved and baptised** (Matthew 28:19-20).

TESTIMONY

Disciples visited a poor family in rural north India who initially rejected their words. They left an audio device with Bible stories and discussion questions. Months later, they returned to find the family and others transformed, baptised and joyfully sharing God's Word across nearby villages.

SUNDAY 21 DECEMBER 2025

SALVATION OF ADOPTED CHILDREN

God sets the solitary in families... (Psalm 68:6).

Pray the Word: Psalm 139:1-6; James 1:27; Ephesians 1:3-14

Let us pray

- Pray for adopted children to **experience the love of God the Father** through their parents.
- Ask that they will know and understand that they have a **God-given purpose** and live their lives free from rejection and doubt.
- Pray for wisdom for the adoptive parents to raise their **children in the ways of God**.

TESTIMONY

After years of rejection—being told she was not the right cultural or family match—a woman finally became the mother of a four-year-old. Through countless tears and disappointments, she discovered a deeper truth: sometimes God is adopting you into a love far greater than anything you ever dreamed of.
