24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL 8-14 DECEMBER 2025

In a world marked by moral decline and shifting values, believers sense an urgent call to prayer. Though headlines reveal humanity's distance from God, there is still hope. History shows a divine thread of redemption running through generations who walked faithfully with Him. Their obedience brought blessings to both their natural and spiritual descendants.

In this second week of our series, 'Focus on family', join us in seeking the Lord and praying for families to declare, "As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord," leaving behind a lasting legacy of moral strength, respect for others and steadfast devotion to God.

MONDAY 8 DECEMBER 2025 FIRST GENERATION BELIEVERS

"My Spirit who is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your descendants, nor from the mouth of your descendants' descendants," says the LORD, "from this time and forevermore." (Isaiah 59:21).

Let us pray

- Pray for **first-generation Christian families** who have endured disownment, rejection and loneliness in their pursuit of Jesus.
- Pray for them to confess and renounce any false practices or involvement in works of darkness that were part of their former belief system.

Declare over families in your community: The Spirit of God will rest on you and your next generation as you take heed to Him.

TUESDAY 9 DECEMBER 2025

LEAVING A SPIRITUAL HERITAGE

One generation shall praise Your works to another, and shall declare Your mighty acts. (Psalm 145:4).

Let us pray

- Pray for **parents and grandparents** to share testimonies of God's goodness and faithfulness with the younger generation.
- Pray that **children and youth will** personally encounter God and boldly share what He is doing in their generation with older believers.
- Ask God's **forgiveness for the disconnection between generations** caused by hearts that have grown lukewarm or turned away from Him.

Declare over families in your city: You shall praise and declare God's works and mighty acts.

WEDNESDAY 10 DECEMBER 2025

SPIRITUAL MENTORSHIP

...when I call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice, and I am persuaded is in you also. (2 Timothy 1:5).

Let us pray

- Pray for parents – **especially those who did not grow up in Christian homes** – to be guided by Spirit-filled mentors who will help them walk in God's wisdom and truth.
- Pray for family counsellors to offer holistic, Christ-centred guidance that helps **families build strong foundations**, forming individuals who are secure in their identity in Christ and aligned with His purpose for their lives.

Declare over spiritual mentors and disciples: *Walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God. (Colossians 1:10).*

THURSDAY 11 DECEMBER 2025

BE OF DIFFERENT SPIRIT

And Jabez called on the God of Israel saying, "Oh, that You would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that Your hand would be with me, and that You would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain!" So God granted him what he requested. (1 Chronicles 4:10).

Let us pray

- Pray for parents to earnestly call on God to reveal to them **habits or attitudes rooted in past trauma or sin**.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to help them **break free from these patterns** and walk in the healing of God's truth.
- Pray that as parents are transformed, their **restoration will impact their children and future generations**.

Declare over broken families: *God has not given (you) a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind. (2 Timothy 1:7).*

FRIDAY 12 DECEMBER 2025

PRAYERS FOR THOSE WHO WILL BELIEVE AFTER YOU

"I pray for them. I do not pray for the world but for those whom You have given Me, for they are Yours." (John 17:9). Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth. (John 17:17)

Let us pray

- Pray for mentors and disciple-makers to follow Jesus' example by **regularly interceding for the spiritual protection** of those they lead.
- Children are the 'in-house' disciples of parents. Ask that parents will consistently **bless and pray for their children**, watching over their spiritual well-being.
- Pray for both mentors and parents to seek and **depend on God as the Source of all wisdom** – to meditate on His Word and never compromise His truth.

Declare over young disciples in your family: *Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the man who trusts in Him! (Psalm 34:8).*

SATURDAY 13 DECEMBER 2025

PASSING ON SKILLS

All these were under the direction of their father for the music in the house of the LORD... (1 Chronicles 25:6).

Let us pray

- Pray for fathers to be actively involved in their children's lives – guiding them through every season with prayer, encouragement and godly counsel.
- Pray for **father figures and mentors** to discern the God-given gifts in the younger generation and to nurture these talents in the fear of the Lord.
- Ask that **practical skills, creative abilities and entrepreneurial wisdom** be passed on from parents to children, breaking cycles of unemployment and dependency in families and communities.

Declare over talents and gifts within families: Your gifts will make room for you (Proverbs 18:16). *Trust in the LORD, and do good; dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness. (Psalm 37:3).*

SUNDAY 14 DECEMBER 2025

TEACHING PARENTS

My son, hear the instruction of your father, and do not forsake the law of your mother; for they will be a graceful ornament on your head, and chains about your neck. (Proverbs 1:8-9).

Let us pray

- Pray for **mothers and fathers to fulfil their God-given responsibility** and authority with humility and complete dependence on Him.
- Ask that **mothers nurture and guide their children with love, gentleness and comfort**. Pray that they cast their cares upon the Lord.
- God's heart is reflected through the **wisdom, love and discipline of fathers**. Pray for fathers to seek God earnestly, so His character is revealed to their children through their lives.

Declare over parents: *Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it. (Proverbs 22:6).*
