7 PROMISES OF JESUS' RETURN

"Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me... I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also."

(John 14:1-3)

24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL 5-11 JANUARY 2026

The promise of Jesus' return anchors our hope and fuels revival in weary hearts. His second coming reminds us that everything in this world is leading to His ultimate victory and that every tear, trial and act of faith holds eternal purpose.

In the third of the three-part series, *Proclaim the Saviour*, we pray to live ready, intercede with passion and proclaim the Gospel with boldness until every promise of Jesus' glorious return is fulfilled before all nations.

MONDAY 5 JANUARY 2026

THE PROMISE OF HIS RETURN

"...This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven." (Acts 1:9-11).

As Jesus ascended, angels declared that He would come again in the same way. This assurance gives meaning to our waiting. His return is not an idea but a divine certainty. Revival begins where hope is rekindled for His appearing.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord Jesus to awaken a fresh expectation in His Church for His promised return (Titus 2:13).
 - Pray for the Holy Spirit to stir a fresh longing for the coming King (Revelation 22:20).
 - Ask Him to help believers live watchfully, with their lamps burning and their hearts alert (Matthew 25:1-13).
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TUESDAY 6 JANUARY 2026

THE PROMISE OF REWARD

"And behold, I am coming quickly and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work."
(Revelation 22:12).

Jesus comes with His reward, not of earthly wealth but eternal inheritance. Every act of obedience, unseen prayer and quiet sacrifice will be honoured. Revival renews passion to live for eternal things, not temporary gain.

Let us pray

- Pray that God will remind us that He is the Rewarder of those who diligently seek Him (Hebrews 11:6).
- Ask Him to strengthen weary servants who labour in secret, unseen but known by Him (Galatians 6:9).
- Pray that the hope of eternal reward will purify motives and sustain endurance, so every act of service brings glory to Christ alone (1 Corinthians 15:58).

WEDNESDAY 7 JANUARY 2026

THE PROMISE OF RESURRECTION LIFE

...For the trumpet will sound and the dead will be raised incorruptible and we shall be changed.
(1 Corinthians 15:51-52).

Death does not have the final word. At His return, the dead in Christ will rise and we will be changed. This hope conquers fear and empowers believers to live with courage.

Let us pray

- Give thanks to the Lord Jesus for the promise of resurrection life and victory over the grave (John 11:25-26).
- Ask Him to fill His people with unshakable hope in the promise of eternal life through the power of His resurrection (1 Corinthians 15:52-54; Romans 8:11).
- Pray that the Lord will let the power of His resurrection stir deeper holiness, faith and courage to live boldly for Christ each day (Philippians 3:10-11).

THURSDAY 8 JANUARY 2026

THE PROMISE OF JUSTICE

...And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True and in righteousness He judges and makes war.
(Revelation 19:11).

The returning Christ is not only the Saviour but the Righteous Judge. He will set all things right, vindicating the oppressed and silencing wickedness. Revival cries out for justice that flows from His throne.

Let us pray

- Pray that God will establish His righteous judgments on the earth, bringing truth, mercy and restoration where wickedness once prevailed (Psalm 96:13).
- Ask Him to strengthen those who suffer for truth and that justice will run like a river (Amos 5:24).
- Pray that the Lord will prepare His people to stand in holy awe before the Judge of all (2 Corinthians 5:10).

FRIDAY 9 JANUARY 2026
THE PROMISE OF RESTORATION

...so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Jesus Christ...
(Acts 3:19-21).

Jesus will return to restore all things. Every broken system, relationship and creation will be renewed.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Holy Spirit will breathe renewal into people's weary hearts and revive their first love for Jesus (Psalm 51:10-12).

SATURDAY 10 JANUARY 2026
THE PROMISE OF HIS GLORY REVEALED

...and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory...
(Matthew 24:30-31).

When Christ returns, His glory will fill the heavens and every eye will see Him. Revival awakens anticipation for that day and calls believers to reflect His light now while waiting for the fullness of His glory.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will transform His Church to reflect His glory (2 Corinthians 3:18).

SUNDAY 11 JANUARY 2026
THE PROMISE OF ETERNAL FELLOWSHIP

..."God Himself will be with them and be their God..." (Revelation 21:3-4).

The greatest promise of all is that God Himself will dwell with His people. No more death, sorrow, or pain, only unbroken fellowship with the Lamb.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to let our worship on earth echo the sound of heaven: *"Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"* (Revelation 7:9-10).
