24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL

2-8 February 2026

As we prepare for the first special week of 24-7 prayer of 2026, themed 'Transforming our communities' (16-22 February), we start focusing our prayers on communities. During this first of a two-week series, 'Blessing my community', let us ask God to restore the places where we live and work and gather. Communities carry wounds, experience pressures and spiritual battles that are unseen. We seek the Lord to heal what is broken, revive what is weary and establish His peace, righteousness and favour in every neighbourhood.

MONDAY 2 FEBRUARY 2026

A COMMUNITY COVERED BY GOD'S PRESENCE

"The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face shine upon you and be gracious to you..."
(Numbers 6:24-26).

Communities thrive when God's presence works within them. It changes the atmosphere, brings peace and hope, restores relationships and people experience divine protection. The power of darkness weakens and the Lord's presence releases renewal that human effort cannot produce, shaping the environment with His peace, favour and goodness.

Let us pray

- Pray that God's peace will descend upon your community (Numbers 6:26).
 - Ask that God's presence will silence fear, division and confusion (Exodus 33:14).
 - Pray that every home will experience God's blessing and protection (Psalm 29:11).

TUESDAY 3 FEBRUARY 2026

A COMMUNITY THAT WALKS IN JUSTICE

...And what does the LORD require of you But to do justly, to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God? (Micah 6:8).

Renewal begins when justice shapes the heart of a community. Where justice is upheld, dignity is protected and the vulnerable are valued. God desires communities where fairness guides decisions, leaders act with integrity and compassion influences every relationship. When justice prevails, peace follows. Righteousness unravels corruption and restores trust, making room for God's blessing to rest on the land.

Let us pray

- Pray for leaders of your community to act with fairness and integrity (Micah 6:8).
- Ask for the protection of the weak and overlooked (Psalm 82:3).
- Pray for unjust practices to be exposed and corrected (Isaiah 1:17).

WEDNESDAY 4 FEBRUARY 2026

A COMMUNITY THAT SEEKS THE WELFARE OF THE CITY

And seek the peace of the city... and pray to the LORD for it; for in its peace you will have peace. (Jeremiah 29:7).

A renewed community seeks the well-being of every neighbourhood. Blessing multiplies where people care for the peace, safety and prosperity of the city. God desires communities where relationships flourish, the economy strengthens, families thrive and cooperation increases. When peace reigns, God's favour rests on the land, opening doors for growth, unity and stability that benefit all who live there.

Let us pray

- Pray for peace to reign in every neighbourhood (Jeremiah 29:7).
- Ask the Lord to prosper local businesses and workers (Psalm 128:2).
- Pray for unity and cooperation among residents (Psalm 133:1).

THURSDAY 5 FEBRUARY 2026

A COMMUNITY STRENGTHENED BY LOVE

Let all that you do be done with love. (1 Corinthians 16:14).

Love is the foundation of true renewal. It heals wounded hearts, repairs broken relationships and restores dignity. A community strengthened by love becomes a haven where compassion flourishes and hope is revitalised. God's love softens hardened attitudes, breaks down barriers and brings unity across generations and cultures. Where love increases, division loses its influence and blessing flows freely.

Let us pray

- Pray for love to guide decisions, conversations and relationships (1 Corinthians 16:14).
- Pray for forgiveness and reconciliation where relationships are strained (Colossians 3:13).
- Pray for acts of kindness to multiply in your community (Galatians 5:14).

FRIDAY 6 FEBRUARY 2026

A COMMUNITY FILLED WITH WISDOM

For the LORD gives wisdom; From His mouth come knowledge and understanding. (Proverbs 2:6).

Every community needs wisdom to navigate challenges and growth. God's wisdom brings clarity where confusion reigns and stability where uncertainty prevails. When wisdom influences leaders, families and institutions, decisions become life-giving and problems find godly solutions. A wise community is strengthened, protected and prepared for future challenges, making room for renewal to take root and flourish.

Let us pray

- Pray for God's wisdom to guide community leaders (Proverbs 2:6).
- Pray for wise decision-making in schools, businesses and homes (James 1:5).
- Pray against confusion, deception and foolish choices (Proverbs 3:5-6).

SATURDAY 7 FEBRUARY 2026

A COMMUNITY THAT KNOWS PEACE

The work of righteousness will be peace and the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever. (Isaiah 32:17).

Peace is a sign of God's renewing work in a community. His peace calms fear, resolves conflict and restores emotional and spiritual stability. When peace fills neighbourhoods, families flourish and trust increases. God's peace replaces anxiety with assurance and brings a sense of safety that transforms daily life. Where His peace dwells, renewal becomes visible and long-lasting.

Let us pray

- Pray for God's peace to calm anxiety and fear in your community (Isaiah 32:17).
- Pray for peaceful relationships between neighbours (Romans 12:18).
- Ask God to remove the roots of violence and conflict (Psalm 34:14).

SUNDAY 8 FEBRUARY 2026

A COMMUNITY ROOTED IN RIGHTEOUSNESS

They shall be My people And I will be their God, in truth and righteousness.' (Zechariah 8:8).

Righteousness is essential for lasting renewal. When individuals, families and leaders walk in integrity, the spiritual atmosphere shifts and blessings increase. Righteousness weakens corruption, restores moral strength and establishes godly values. A community rooted in righteousness reflects God's character, opening the way for His favour, protection and peace to rest upon the land.

Let us pray

- Pray for righteousness to influence laws, leadership and culture (Proverbs 14:34).
- Pray for God's people to stand boldly for the truth (Ephesians 6:14).
- Pray that corruption and evil will lose their influence (Psalm 97:10).
