And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them?
(Luke 18:7)

This is the last week in our 3-part series, 'The Three Promises'. We will remind God of His promises connected to day-and-night prayer. This week, we ask the Lord to provide justice for the nations as we call on His name (Luke 18:7).

As we intercede for the nations, let us also bring before the Lord the needs within our own families, communities, neighbourhoods and cities. May He awaken our hearts to pray faithfully for the places where we live and serve.

MONDAY 26 JANUARY 2026

FINANCIAL VULNERABILITY

I know that the LORD will maintain the cause of the afflicted and justice for the poor. (Psalm 140:12).

An estimated 808 million people globally live in extreme poverty.

Let us pray

- Pray for poverty-stricken people to call on God for mercy (Psalm 34:6).
- Pray for wisdom for congregations working alongside social workers to supply both physical nourishment and spiritual guidance to those in need within your community.
- Pray that individuals will embrace training offered by non-profit organisations, overcome their circumstances and grow into capable, skilled contributors to society.

Proclaim God's justice: *"For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, Now I will arise," says the LORD; "I will set him in the safety for which he yearns."* (Psalm 12:5).

TUESDAY 27 JANUARY 2026

MODERN-DAY SLAVERY

Deliver me, O my God, out of the hand of the wicked... (Psalm 71:4).

Modern-day slavery extends beyond trafficking. It includes forced marriage, state-imposed labour, debt bondage and other forms of exploitation. Approximately **50 million people worldwide were living in modern slavery in 2021.**

Let us pray

- Fervently pray for trafficking rings and syndicates to be exposed by God's light.
- Pray for effective collaboration between governments, law enforcement and judicial systems to free the oppressed.
- Pray also that the Lord will reveal His love and grace to the oppressed. Ask the Holy Spirit to help them not to harden their hearts towards God because of their hardship.

Proclaim God's justice: *Let the wicked forsake his way and the unrighteous man his thoughts; let him return to the LORD and He will have mercy on him... (Isaiah 55:7).*

WEDNESDAY 28 JANUARY 2026

REFUGEE AND MIGRATION CRISES

"I was a stranger and you took Me in..." (Matthew 25:35c).

About 117 million people worldwide are displaced by war, conflict, or persecution. Behind these statistics are real people – families separated, children growing up without stability and communities struggling to rebuild.

Let us pray

- Ask God to guide refugee-hosting nations and communities to respond with wisdom and compassion.
- Pray for the global Church to welcome and support those who are displaced, showing the love of Christ in tangible ways.
- Pray for the members at your local congregation not to *forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some have unwittingly entertained angels.* (Hebrews 13:2).

Proclaim God's justice: *You have been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm... (Isaiah 25:4).*

THURSDAY 29 JANUARY 2026

ACCESS TO EDUCATION

But let justice run down like water and righteousness like a mighty stream. (Amos 5:24).

About 251 million children worldwide are not attending school and more than 600 million are enrolled yet they are still unable to achieve basic proficiency in reading and mathematics.

Let us pray

- Pray for dedicated teachers to teach children in rural communities, refugee camps and remote regions.
- Ask the Lord to open doors for digital resources to reach children in remote areas.
- Pray for sufficient resources to support children with diverse learning abilities, enabling them to develop practical skills that reflect their God-given potential.

Proclaim God's justice: *The LORD executes righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed (Psalm 103:6).*

FRIDAY 30 JANUARY 2026

CORRUPTION AND POOR GOVERNANCE

Dishonest scales are an abomination to the LORD, but a just weight is His delight. (Proverbs 11:1).

Political laws enacted by governments directly impact the lives of individuals, communities and even the Church. Corruption is a persistent global threat that fosters instability and contributes to human rights violations.

Let us pray

- Pray for local and national leaders and ask God to give them wisdom, righteousness and integrity.
- Pray for the Church to support and disciple Christians called to serve in public office, policymaking, or governance – encouraging them to be salt and light in those influential arenas (Matthew 5:13-16).

Proclaim God's justice: *He changes the times and the seasons; He removes kings and raises up kings.... (Daniel 2:21).*

SATURDAY 31 JANUARY 2026

LACK OF ACCESS TO JUSTICE

He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the LORD. (Psalm 33:5).

More than 5.1 billion people lack **access to justice**. This is caused, among other factors, by unaffordable legal representation, weak or corrupt justice systems and limited legal awareness resulting from low literacy and inadequate community legal support.

Let us pray

- Pray that all who uphold justice will act with integrity and honour before God in every decision they make (Micah 6:8).
- Pray for the illiterate and impoverished not to be exploited in any way and that righteous people will lift their voice on behalf of those who cannot speak for themselves (Proverbs 31:9).

Proclaim God's justice: *"Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints!" (Revelation 15:3).*

SUNDAY 1 FEBRUARY 2026

FOOD INSECURITY

The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. (Psalm 23:1).

About 2.3 billion people experienced moderate or severe food insecurity in 2024. The majority of severe food insecurity is concentrated in regions affected by **armed conflict**, **climate-related disasters** and **economic downturns**, which disrupt food production and access.

Let us pray

- Pray that God will bring justice where aid for the poor is being withheld and inspire sustainable solutions that enable people to live off the land.
- According to Luke 21:11, natural disasters will continue and worsen. Pray for the **Church to be prepared** for such events, extending comfort, aid and hope to those who suffer loss, displacement and hardship due to these calamities.

Proclaim God's justice: *The eyes of all look expectantly to You and You give them their food in due season. (Psalm 145:15).*
