24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL 2 - 8 MARCH 2026

God is love. From the beginning, He created mankind to live in devoted fellowship with Him. The design of marriage, family and every human relationship flows from His loving nature.

This week, we will pray for godly relationships that bear the fruit of the Holy Spirit.

Join us during the '**30 Days of Ramadan**' from **17 February - 18 March 2026** as we pray in an informed and focused manner for Muslims – sharing their burdens, understanding their concerns and petitioning God for their salvation.

MONDAY 2 MARCH 2026

LOVE WITHIN MARRIAGE

Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh. (Genesis 2:24).

The Bible presents marriage as a covenant relationship, instituted by God between a natural man and a natural woman. Ephesians 5:31-32 teaches that the union of husband and wife is a profound mystery illustrating Christ's sacrificial love for the Church.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to protect marriages from cultural compromise and to anchor them securely in His Word.
- Pray that each union reflects His intended pattern of covenant love.
- Ask that biblical marriages reflect Christ's sacrificial love for the Church.

Practical tip: Encourage a young couple to pursue marriage preparation rooted in Scripture.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

DAY 14

BAHRAIN

The LORD opens the eyes of the blind... (Psalm 146:8).

Christians from Muslim backgrounds often face intense family and social pressure.

Muslims in Bahrain: 1,111,500 (74% of population)

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will open spiritual eyes across Bahrain and reveal the glory of Christ to those seeking truth.
- Ask the Lord to draw weary and burdened Bahrainis into the rest and compassion of the Lord Jesus, awakening hunger for salvation.

TUESDAY 3 MARCH 2026

LOVE AMONG SIBLINGS

But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection. (Colossians 3:14).

Life with siblings shapes our character, teaching us the importance of generosity, conflict resolution and acceptance of others. Strengthened by patience and mutual acceptance, siblings share a deep bond of love.

Let us pray

- Pray for parents to create a fair and equal home environment for siblings.
- Ask that God's love will strengthen the bond between biological and adopted siblings.
- Pray for reconciliation in family feuds among adult siblings through the Blood of Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:18).

Practical tip: Send your sibling a short prayer by text message and encourage your children to do the same.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

DAY 15

OMAN

The LORD is gracious and full of compassion... (Psalm 145:8).

Converts from Islam practise their faith quietly due to legal and societal constraints.

Muslims in Oman: 4,858,000 (85.9% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to draw the people of Oman into an encounter with Jesus, revealing His compassion and truth.
- Pray for the seed of the Gospel to take root throughout Oman, producing transformed lives that testify to His mercy and power.

WEDNESDAY 4 MARCH 2026

PARENTAL LOVE (FATHER)

As a father pities his children, so the LORD pities those who fear Him. (Psalm 103:13).

The Bible portrays a father's love as compassionate, guiding and protective (Luke 15:20). Loving discipline reflects the nurturing heart of our heavenly Father (Proverbs 4:1-4).

Let us pray

- Ask our heavenly Father to reveal His love to fathers.
- Pray for healing and restoration in strained father-child relationships.
- Pray that Christian fathers will abide in God's presence and seek His counsel daily (John 15:1-7).

Practical tip: Fathers, spend intentional one-to-one time with your child(ren), doing an activity of their choice. Mentors, make an appointment with your disciple in the Lord for a time of prayer together.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

DAY 16

QATAR

...the LORD raises those who are bowed down... (Psalm 146:8).

Public evangelism and conversion from Islam are prohibited.

Muslims in Qatar: 2.4 million (70-75% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask God to reveal the glory of the Lord Jesus to Qataris, breaking through deception and unveiling divine truth.
- Pray for the Word of God to be spread through this country, softening hearts and preparing Qatar for a harvest of redeemed lives.

THURSDAY 5 MARCH 2026

PARENTAL LOVE (MOTHER)

She watches over the ways of her household... Her children rise up and call her blessed; her husband also... (Proverbs 31:27 – 28)

A mother's love is steadfast, self-giving and tenderly nurturing, reflecting in many ways the compassionate love God has for His children.

Let us pray

- Pray for mothers to be deeply rooted and grounded in the love of Christ (Ephesians 3:17-19).
- Pray for mothers who struggle to nurture with tenderness, that the Lord will heal past wounds and break cycles of pain (1 Chronicles 4:10).

Practical tip: Write a note of affirmation or a Bible verse for your child and place it in their lunchbox or on their pillow as a reminder of your love and God's faithfulness.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

DAY 17

UNITED ARAB EMIRATES

The LORD builds up Jerusalem... (Psalm 147:2).

Sharing the Christian faith with Muslims is legally restricted.

Muslims in the United Arab Emirates: 7.1 million (76% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask God to stir spiritual hunger among Emiratis, revealing the Lord Jesus as the only One who satisfies the longing of the heart.
- Pray that the Lord will draw the Emiratis into the truth that gives eternal life.

FRIDAY 6 MARCH 2026

FRIENDSHIP

A friend loves at all times... (Proverbs 17:17a).

Godly friendships are built on trust, honesty and love, guided by God's will and Word (Proverbs 27:17). Not all friendships are beneficial; some can lead a person away from God (Proverbs 13:20; 1 Corinthians 15:33).

Let us pray

- Pray that young people entering new settings (e.g., schools, neighbourhoods or culture) will seek God's wisdom in forming healthy friendships.
- Ask the Lord to guard platonic friendships between the opposite genders, keeping them pure despite cultural pressure to turn them into romantic relationships.

Practical tip: Pray with a young person for godly friends.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

DAY 18

NIGERIA

The Lord is my light and my salvation... (Psalm 27:1).

Christians face violence, abductions, displacement and church attacks.

Muslims in Nigeria: 97 million (50-57% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask God to reveal the glory of Jesus to Muslims across Nigeria, breaking fear and unveiling the truth that leads to eternal life.
- Pray for the love of Christ to touch wounded communities, uproot hostility and establish healing and hearts that are open to the Gospel.

SATURDAY 7 MARCH 2026

LOVE BEFORE MARRIAGE

Love suffers long and is kind... (1 Corinthians 13:4).

Love should not be based solely on feelings, convenience, or romantic attraction. Strong physical attraction is not the primary sign of love. Biblically, love is rooted in sacrifice and commitment (1 Corinthians 13). It is a choice of the will.

Let us pray

- Pray that couples preparing for engagement and marriage will pursue the biblical boundaries of intimacy and purity, deepening their understanding of God's covenant love (1 Corinthians 6:18; Colossians 3:5).
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will lead their conversations and align their plans with His will, strengthening them in every area of life.

Practical tip: Discuss with your son or daughter the biblical view of love and how it differs from the way love is portrayed in films or in their peers' relationships.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

DAY 19

TUNISIA

The LORD is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble... (Nahum 1:7).

For Christians, social hostility and family pressure severely limit public expression and growth.

Muslims in Tunisia: 10.2 million (98-99% of population)

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to draw seekers into encounters with His love, softening hearts to receive truth with courage and humility.
- Pray for the light of the Gospel to spread across Tunisia, transforming families and awakening genuine faith.

SUNDAY 8 MARCH 2026

RESPECT FOR PARENTS

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. (Ephesians 6:1).

The Lord commands children to honour their parents. Their inward respect should be accompanied by outward acts of obedience (Exodus 20:12).

Let us pray

- Pray for children to respect and honour their parents out of reverence and love for the Lord.
- Ask that children will show their parents grace, even if they have neglected their parental responsibilities towards their children.

Practical tip: Invite a parent and child with a strained relationship for a conversation over coffee/tea, creating a safe space for listening and prayer.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

DAY 20

MALI

...The Lord is the strength of my life... (Psalm 27:1).

Christians face violent instability and pressure from extremist groups.

Muslims in Mali: 18 million (90% of population)

Let us pray

- Pray that Jesus Christ will be revealed to Malians living under fear and spiritual oppression and for them to be drawn into His refuge and salvation.
 - Ask for the peace of Christ to overcome violence and fear, bringing stability and hope across this troubled region.
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
