MONDAY 16 MARCH 2026

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

DAY 28: ALBANIA

The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in mercy. (Psalm 145:8).

Christians enjoy freedom but witness in a secular society.

Muslims in Albania: 1,217,000 (50.7% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to reveal the compassion of Christ to Albanians, drawing searching hearts into the truth that brings salvation.
- Pray that the light of the Gospel will break through unbelief and awaken faith where old ideologies created emptiness.

TUESDAY 17 MARCH 2026

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

DAY 29: AZERBAIJAN

...Those who dwelt in the land of the shadow of death, upon them a light has shined. (Isaiah 9:2)

Christians are prohibited from evangelising openly.

Muslims in Azerbaijan: 10 million (97% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to draw the Azerbaijani into the light of Christ, removing fear and revealing the One who brings salvation and truth.
- Pray that the Gospel will take root in Azerbaijani families, bringing transformation, courage and faith that endures.

WEDNESDAY 18 MARCH 2026

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

DAY 30: TURKMENISTAN

The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? (Psalm 27:1).

Christians live under very severe restrictions and repression.

Muslims in Turkmenistan: 5.8 million (93% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to shine His light in hidden places, freeing those oppressed by spiritual darkness and awakening a longing for truth and eternal life.
 - Pray for the Gospel to spread through friendships, planting seeds of faith that transform communities across Turkmenistan.
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THURSDAY 19 MARCH 2026

LIGHT OF CHRIST BREAKING THROUGH

For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. (2 Corinthians 4:6).

Let us give thanks

- Lord Jesus, we exalt You as the Light that darkness cannot overcome. We thank You for piercing spiritual blindness during Ramadan and revealing Your glory to searching hearts.
 - Father, we magnify You for sovereign encounters, dreams, Scriptures and divine appointments that unveiled Christ as Saviour.
 - Holy Spirit, we honour You for dispelling deception and establishing truth. All praise belongs to the Lord Jesus Christ alone.
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FRIDAY 20 MARCH 2026

NEW BIRTH AND FREEDOM

Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed. (John 8:36).

Let us give thanks

- Lord Jesus, we thank You for breaking chains of fear, tradition and religious striving. Thank You for true freedom and the miracle of new birth.
 - Father, we bless You that those who once sought righteousness through works now rest in the finished work of Christ.
 - Holy Spirit, we praise You for transforming hearts, renewing minds and sealing new believers as children of God.
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SATURDAY 21 MARCH 2026

BOLDNESS IN CONFESSION

...And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness. (Acts 4:31).

Let us give thanks

- Lord Jesus, we thank You for Christians filled with courage rising in places of pressure. Thank You that Your Name is confessed boldly.
 - Father, we praise You that fear has bowed to faith and silence has given way to testimony.
 - Holy Spirit, we honour You for strengthening believers to stand firm and proclaim Christ without compromise.
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SUNDAY 22 MARCH 2026
LASTING FRUIT AND HARVEST

Let us give thanks
