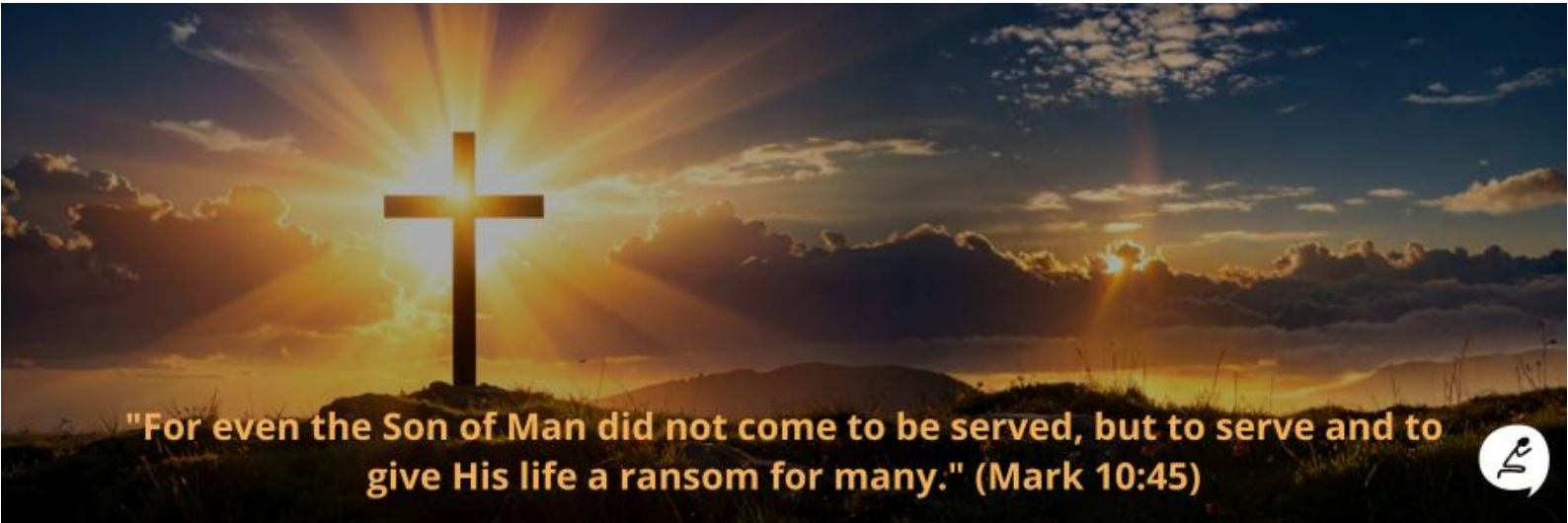

PREPARING FOR THE CROSS

7 ENCOUNTERS WITH JESUS

In the days leading up to His crucifixion, the Lord Jesus intentionally prepared His disciples for His death on the cross. Through encounters, teaching, prayer and the final meal they shared, He revealed the depth of His sacrificial mission.

As we reflect on these moments, we ask the Holy Spirit to prepare our own hearts to understand the cross more deeply, to walk in humility and obedience and to testify boldly about Jesus Christ, our crucified and risen Saviour.

MONDAY 23 MARCH 2026

RECOGNISING THE WORTH OF JESUS

Scripture Reading: John 12:1-8

..."Let her alone; she has kept this for the day of My burial." (John 12:7).

True preparation for the cross begins with a deep revelation of the worth of Jesus Christ. When we see Jesus for who He truly is, devotion flows naturally and sacrifice becomes joyful.

Ask yourself

Do I value the Lord Jesus above my comfort, reputation and earthly security?

In Bethany, Mary anointed Jesus with costly perfume (**John 12:1-8**). While others criticised her act, Jesus recognised it as preparation for His burial. Mary's devotion revealed spiritual insight into what was about to happen.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to awaken deep devotion to Jesus in the hearts of believers (Philippians 3:8).
- Pray that the Church will treasure the Lord Jesus above all earthly pursuits (Matthew 13:44).

TUESDAY 24 MARCH 2026

WELCOMING THE TRUE KING

Scripture Reading: John 12:12-15

...'BLESSED IS HE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD!'... (John 12:13)

The crowds welcomed Jesus as King, yet many misunderstood His mission. Preparing for the cross requires surrendering to Jesus Christ's rule over every part of our lives.

Ask yourself

Is Jesus truly King in my decisions, priorities and relationships?

During His triumphal entry into Jerusalem (**John 12:12-15**), crowds praised Jesus as the coming King. Yet many expected political deliverance rather than spiritual redemption.

Let us pray

- Thank the Lord Jesus for coming as the humble King who brings salvation (Zechariah 9:9).
 - Ask the Holy Spirit to lead believers into wholehearted surrender to Jesus Christ's authority (Romans 12:1).
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WEDNESDAY 25 MARCH 2026

THE WAY OF HUMBLE SERVICE

Scripture Reading: John 13:1-17

"If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet..."
(John 13:14)

Jesus prepared His disciples for the cross by demonstrating humility and servant leadership.

Ask yourself

Do my actions reflect the servant heart of Jesus Christ?

At the Last Supper, Jesus washed His disciples' feet (**John 13:1-17**). This act illustrated the nature of God's Kingdom: greatness is expressed through humility and service.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to cultivate Christ-like humility in His Church (Philippians 2:5-7).
 - Pray that believers will serve one another in love and sincerity (Galatians 5:13).
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THURSDAY 26 MARCH 2026
A COMMUNITY MARKED BY LOVE

Scripture Reading: John 13:34-35

"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another..." (John 13:34)

Before the cross, Jesus emphasised love as the defining mark of His followers.

Ask yourself

Is the love of Jesus Christ visible in the way I treat others?

Jesus commanded His disciples to love one another as He had loved them (**John 13:34-35**). This sacrificial love would reveal His presence to the world.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to fill His people with the love of God (Romans 5:5).
 - Pray that unity and love among believers will draw others to Jesus (John 13:35).
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FRIDAY 27 MARCH 2026
SURRENDERING TO THE FATHER'S WILL

Scripture Reading: Luke 22:39-46

"...nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done." (Luke 22:42)

Jesus prepared for the cross through prayer and full surrender to the Father.

Ask yourself

Am I willing to follow God's will even when the path is difficult?

In Gethsemane (**Luke 22:39-46**), Jesus prayed in deep agony yet surrendered completely to the Father's plan.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to strengthen believers to obey His will faithfully (Matthew 26:41).
 - Pray for the hearts of people to be fully surrendered to God's purposes (Romans 12:2).
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SATURDAY 28 MARCH 2026

JESUS' PRAYER FOR HIS DISCIPLES

Scripture Reading: John 17

"Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth." (John 17:17)

Before going to the cross, Jesus prayed for His disciples and for all who would believe through their message.

Ask yourself

Am I allowing God's Word to shape and sanctify my life daily?

In His high priestly prayer (**John 17**), Jesus prayed for protection, unity and sanctification for His followers.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to sanctify His people through the truth of His Word (John 17:17).
 - Pray for unity among believers so the world may know Jesus (John 17:21).
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SUNDAY 29 MARCH 2026

REMEMBERING THE SACRIFICE

Scripture Reading: Luke 22:14-20

"...do this in remembrance of Me." (Luke 22:19)

Communion reminds believers of the price that Jesus paid for the salvation of all who believe in Him.

Ask yourself

Do I live daily in grateful remembrance of Jesus' sacrifice?

During the Last Supper (**Luke 22:14-20**), Jesus shared bread and wine with His disciples, referring to His body and blood He would sacrifice for the salvation of the world.

Let us pray

- Give thanks to the Lord Jesus for His sacrifice that reconciles us to God (Colossians 1:20).
 - Pray that believers will live lives worthy of the Gospel of Jesus (Philippians 1:27).
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
