MONDAY 9 MARCH 2026 LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOUR

So which of these three do you think was neighbor to him who fell among the thieves? And he said, "He who showed mercy on him." Then Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise." (Luke 10:36-37).

Bible reading: Luke 10:27-37

Consider:

Mercy defines a true neighbour. Where can I extend compassion today?

Let us pray

- Ask the Holy Spirit to open your eyes to everyday opportunities to show kindness – commuting together, in shops, or queues.
- Pray for mercy ministries in your congregation to remain faithful and fruitful.
- Intercede for government services that care for the abused, orphaned, addicted and vulnerable.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

Day 21: KUWAIT

'Call to Me, and I will answer you...' (Jeremiah 33:3).

Christians worship quietly within limits.

Muslims in Kuwait: 3.5 million (75% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to grant Muslims in Kuwait dreams and clear revelations of the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - Pray that the Holy Spirit will soften hearts and open doors for the Gospel to be proclaimed with wisdom and courage.
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TUESDAY 10 MARCH 2026

WALK IN LOVE

And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma. (Ephesians 5:2).

Bible reading: Ephesians 5: 1-13

Consider:

Is Christ's sacrificial love the pattern of my relationships?

Do goodness, righteousness and truth characterise my actions?

Let us pray

- Intercede for believers to give generously of their lives, time and resources as worship to our heavenly Father.
- Pray that such love will become a testimony that leads others to salvation.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

Day 22: SOMALIA

For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness... (2 Corinthians 4:6).

Christians live peacefully but with little evangelistic freedom.

Muslims in Somalia: 19.5 million (99.7% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to shine the light of Christ into Somalia and open blind eyes to behold His glory.
 - Pray that the Holy Spirit will raise bold witnesses whose transformed lives proclaim salvation in the Lord Jesus Christ alone.
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WEDNESDAY 11 MARCH 2026

FORGIVE FREELY

And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you. (Ephesians 4:32).

Bible reading: Ephesians 4:20-32

Consider:

Am I holding on to offence, or releasing it to the Lord?

Let us pray

- Ask the Holy Spirit to soften your heart and empower you to forgive sincerely.
- Pray for unity in your nation, that love would overcome historical wounds and that reconciliation would flourish through honest conversation and grace.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

Day 23: KAZAKHSTAN

Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed. (John 8:36).

Christians face increasing legal pressure.

Muslims in Kazakhstan: 13.8 million (70.2% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask God to awaken dissatisfaction with ritual and to draw Muslims in Kazakhstan into true reconciliation through the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - Pray that the Holy Spirit will establish faithful believers who proclaim the Gospel steadfastly under pressure.
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THURSDAY 12 MARCH 2026

PRAY FOR OTHERS

... praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints... (Ephesians 6:18).

Bible reading: Ephesians 6: 10-19

Consider:

Is my love expressed through faithful intercession?

Let us pray

- Follow Christ's example in John 17, pray intentionally for those you mentor, disciple, or influence spiritually.
- Pray that the Body of Christ may overflow in love and righteousness, prepared for the day of Christ and reflecting His glory (Philippians 1:9-11).

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

Day 24: UZBEKISTAN

..."I am the bread of life..." (John 6:35).

Christians are restricted and monitored.

Muslims in Uzbekistan: 31.7 million (88% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask the Father to reveal the Lord Jesus as the Bread of Life, who alone satisfies every fasting Muslim's soul.
 - Pray that the Holy Spirit will prepare divine appointments that lead many to confess the Lord Jesus as Lord.
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FRIDAY 13 MARCH 2026

SHOW HOSPITALITY

Be hospitable to one another without grumbling. (1 Peter 4:9).

Bible reading: 1 Peter 4:8-11

Consider:

Does my hospitality reflect the welcoming heart of God?

Do others encounter peace and grace when they enter my home?

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to stir hearts in your congregation to share meals, prayer and fellowship in their homes (Acts 2:42).
- Intercede for young people facing hardship, that temporary refuge in caring homes may bring renewal and direction.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

Day 25: BANGLADESH

"...Everyone who thirsts, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat..." (Isaiah 55:1).

Christians are a small and vulnerable minority.

Muslims in Bangladesh: 157.6 million (91.04% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask the Father to awaken deep spiritual hunger across Bangladesh and to reveal the Lord Jesus Christ as the Living Water.
- Pray that the Lord to draw the weary into the rest and forgiveness secured at the cross.

SATURDAY 14 MARCH 2026

EDIFYING SPEECH

And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together... (Hebrews 10:24-25a)

Bible reading: Hebrews 10:24-25

Consider:

Do my words strengthen or discourage others?

Do I speak life over myself and those around me?

Let us pray

- Pray for grace to speak truth in love within families, even when correction is needed.
- Pray that Christian fellowship will cultivate speech that strengthens faith and encourages perseverance.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to guard our tongues and replace idle words with grace-filled speech.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

Day 26: MALAYSIA

For by grace you have been saved through faith... (Ephesians 2:8).

Christians worship freely but face restrictions after conversion.

Muslims in Malaysia: 20.6 million (63.5% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask the Father to reveal that salvation is a gift of grace through the Lord Jesus Christ and not earned by works.
 - Pray that the Holy Spirit will raise gentle yet bold witnesses who lead many into the knowledge of the truth.
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SUNDAY 15 MARCH 2026

SHARING THE GOOD NEWS

And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature." (Mark 16:15).

Bible reading: Mark 16:14-20

Consider:

Is Christ's love in me strong enough to overcome my fear of sharing the Gospel?

Let us pray

- Ask the Holy Spirit for sensitivity to recognise divine opportunities to be Christ's witness.
- Persistently pray for unsaved loved ones, trusting the Lord to draw them to Himself.
- Pray that missionaries and evangelists will minister with clarity, courage and accompanying signs that glorify Jesus Christ.

RAMADAN 17 FEBRUARY – 18 MARCH 2026

Day 27: LIBYA

The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? (Psalm 27:1).

Christians in Libya endure extreme pressure and danger from legal restrictions.

Muslims in Libya: 6.6 million (96.6% of the population)

Let us pray

- Ask the Father to reveal the Lord Jesus as Prince of Peace and the only Saviour in Libya.
 - Pray that the Holy Spirit will build a resilient Church and bring forth a harvest of souls despite opposition.
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
