MONDAY 13 APRIL 2026

GLOBAL DEBT

Fact

According to [Reuters](#), global debt reached record levels of around \$348 trillion by the end of 2025. When debt is high, economies become more fragile, growth slows, costs rise and it becomes harder to recover from setbacks.

Faith

... all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the LORD your God: The LORD will open to you His good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hand. You shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow. (Deuteronomy 28:2,12)

Focus

- **Nationwide:** Humbly ask the Lord to guide leaders to grow the economy, reduce unemployment and address inequality.
- **Personal:** Ask the Lord for wisdom in finances, wise spending and responsible debt management.

TUESDAY 14 APRIL 2026

GLOBAL INFLATION

Fact

[World Economic Situation and Prospects 2026](#) reports that inflation is easing, but prices remain high. Food, fuel and housing continue to strain households.

Faith

Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I WILL NEVER LEAVE YOU NOR FORSAKE YOU." So we may boldly say: "THE LORD IS MY HELPER; I WILL NOT FEAR. WHAT CAN MAN DO TO ME?" (Hebrews 13:5-6).

Focus

- **City-wide:** Pray for struggling families in your city to grow in contentment. Also, pray for businesses to be managed with integrity, free from greed and covetousness.
 - **Personal:** Pray that no hardship will extinguish the joy of loving the Lord Jesus in your heart amid rising costs and increasing financial strain.
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WEDNESDAY 15 APRIL 2026

GEOPOLITICAL CONFLICT

Fact

War directly disrupts trade, energy, food systems and shipping routes. Modern wars increasingly function as economic weapons, shaping trade, prices and financial systems worldwide.

Faith

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. (Philippians 4:6-7).

Focus

- **Countries in conflict:** Pray for conflicts worldwide. Ask that tensions be replaced with sincere dialogue and that leaders across all sides be guided towards just and enduring peace.
 - **Personal:** Surrender all concerns about the future before the Lord, asking Him to lead you clearly in matters of provision.
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THURSDAY 16 APRIL 2026

WORKFORCE DISRUPTION CAUSED BY ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI) AND AUTOMATION

Fact

New technologies, such as AI and robotics, are changing the way people work, and many jobs may be replaced, particularly administrative jobs.

Faith

For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. (Ephesians 2:10).

Focus

- **Global influence:** Pray for well-structured policies that uphold biblical ethics, safeguard the vulnerable and promote justice as technology advances.
 - **Personal:** Seek the Lord concerning your career and the future career paths of your children. Ask Him to guide your family as they navigate the evolving world of technology.
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FRIDAY 17 APRIL 2026

CLIMATE-DRIVEN ECONOMIC DAMAGE

Fact

Extreme weather causes over \$2 trillion in damage each year and is making insurance harder to get worldwide ([UNDRR, 2025](#)).

Faith

You visit the earth and water it, You greatly enrich it; the river of God is full of water; You provide their grain, for so You have prepared it. You water its ridges abundantly, You settle its furrows; You make it soft with showers, You bless its growth. You crown the year with Your goodness, and Your paths drip with abundance. (Psalm 65:9-11).

Focus

Agriculture in your country: Pray for national repentance and humility before God, trusting Him to restore the land (2 Chronicles 7:14). Ask for wisdom and resilience for farmers to sustain production, stabilise prices, and navigate financial losses.

Personal: Ask the Lord to guide you in faithful stewardship of your resources and in preparing wisely for times of uncertainty.

SATURDAY 18 APRIL 2026

WEAKENING CONSUMER CONFIDENCE

Fact

Stagnant household incomes and rising debt are placing pressure on savings and spending, contributing to slower economic growth ([OECD](#), [Federal Reserve](#), 2025–2026).

Faith

Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? (Matthew 6:26).

Focus

Households in your community: Pray that breadwinners will trust God as their Provider, remain generous in times of lack, and persevere through financial pressure.

Personal: Depend on the Lord each day for provision. Invite Him into every financial decision, both large and small.

SUNDAY 19 APRIL 2026

ENERGY INSECURITY

Fact

Energy prices are increasingly unpredictable due to global tensions and supply disruptions. This slows economic growth and affects food production and manufacturing ([IMF](#), [World Bank](#), [IEA](#), 2025–2026).

Faith

Though the fig tree may not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines; though the labor of the olive may fail, and the fields yield no food; though the flock may be cut off from the fold, and there be no herd in the stalls— Yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will joy in the God of my salvation. (Habakkuk 3:17-18).

Focus

For the world: Pray that nations with abundant energy resources will steward them responsibly and justly. Ask God to grant creative solutions to countries seeking sustainable energy alternatives.

Personal: Rejoice in the Lord Jesus continually, trusting Him as your Provider and anchoring your heart in His faithfulness through every season.
