



— KNOWING GOD — HEARING HIS VOICE

*The voice of the LORD is powerful;
the voice of the LORD is full of majesty.*

(PSALM 29:4)

24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL 8-14 JUNE 2026

To know God is far more than simply knowing about Him, it is to seek His heart, walk closely with Him, and respond to His voice in faith and obedience. Throughout Scripture, God revealed Himself personally to those who sought Him with humility, faith and surrender.

We invite you to join us in prayer during this three-part series focusing on 'Hearing His Voice.'

Let us set aside time during this second week to reflect on the different ways God spoke to people throughout Scripture and consider how we, too, can incline our ears to hear His voice, discern His leading and follow Him in obedient surrender.

MONDAY 8 JUNE 2026

READ THE WRITTEN WORD, KNOW THE LIVING WORD

The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul... (Psalm 19:7a).

Examples in God's Word: Psalm 1, Revelation 1:3

The Word of God, inspired by the Holy Spirit through about 40 authors over 1,500 years, uniquely reveals God's voice through remarkably interconnected writings spanning vastly different eras.

How do I know it is God's voice or will?

The Holy Spirit will never contradict God's Word. Guard against using only selected verses for guidance, for the entirety of God's Word is truth (Psalm 119:160).

Let us pray

- Pray for **new believers** to spend time in God's Word daily. Ask the Lord to help them **overcome any resistance** to reading their Bibles.
- Also pray for believers to take the necessary time to **seek God's counsel** to make sure that what they have heard is truly God's voice.

TUESDAY 9 JUNE 2026

FOLLOW THE VOICE OF THE SHEPHERD

My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me. (John 10:27).

Examples in God's Word: Psalm 23, 1 Peter 5:1-8

Religious and political leaders in the Old Testament were often referred to as shepherds. The attributes of a true shepherd include care, sacrificial service, love, comfort and loving discipline.

How do I recognise the Shepherd's voice, even when He speaks through leaders?

Write down the words you hear and compare them with the attributes of the Shepherd according to Psalm 23.

Let us pray

- Pray for **discernment for youth at your local congregation** to spiritually discern the voice of Jesus, the Good Shepherd.
- Also pray for spiritual leaders **not to rely on their own understanding**, but to seek the guidance of Jesus first, before making decisions that will influence the lives of those they lead.

WEDNESDAY 10 JUNE 2026

SUPERNATURAL ENCOUNTERS

So he looked, and behold, the bush was burning with fire, but the bush was not consumed. So when the LORD saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." (Exodus 3:2b, 4).

Examples in God's Word: Saul (Acts 9:1-6), John (Revelation 1:10-20)

God is Spirit. He created matter and all things that we see and interact with physically, yet we should not limit our understanding of Him to the natural realm alone.

How do I know whether an encounter was truly spiritual and not simply an emotional experience?

A spiritual encounter with God leads to obedience, spiritual transformation or renewal and bears spiritual fruit that glorifies God's power and might.

Let us pray

- Pray for **believers who have had spiritual encounters with God** to closely walk with the Lord in obedience, humility, surrender and purity.

THURSDAY 11 JUNE 2026

GOD'S AUDIBLE VOICE

... the LORD called Samuel. And he answered, "Here I am!" (1 Samuel 3:4).

Examples in God's Word: Moses (Exodus 3:4), Samuel (1 Samuel 3:4-10), the Lord Jesus' baptism (Matthew 3:17)

At times, according to Scripture, God spoke in a clearly audible way that people could hear.

How do I know the audible voice belongs to God?

God's voice is described as majestic and powerful, distinct from any other voice (Psalm 29). In Scripture, the human response to encountering God's audible voice is often immediate awe, reverential fear, deep humility and utmost respect. There is an unmistakable awareness that it is the voice of God.

Let us pray

- Like Saul, who heard the audible voice of God and was completely transformed to expand His Kingdom, **pray for persecutors of the Church** today to encounter God similarly.

FRIDAY 12 JUNE 2026

THE HOLY SPIRIT

However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. (John 16:13).

The Holy Spirit has spoken to various individuals throughout the Bible, guiding, instructing and empowering them for His kingdom work.

Examples in God's Word: Simeon (Luke 2:25-27), Philip (Acts 8:29), Agabus (Acts 11:28)

How do I know that it is the Holy Spirit speaking to me?

We need the indwelling Holy Spirit, our Helper, to guide us in every season. As the Spirit of Truth, He never contradicts God's Word and reminds us of the Lord Jesus' teachings (John 14:15-26).

Let us pray

- Pray for Christian children to learn to hear the Holy Spirit's voice.
- Pray for **missionaries and evangelists** to follow His leading and faithfully introduce new believers to God the Father, the Lord Jesus and the Holy Spirit.

SATURDAY 13 JUNE 2026

DREAMS AND VISIONS

"Please hear this dream which I have dreamed: There we were, binding sheaves in the field. Then behold, my sheaf arose and also stood upright; and indeed your sheaves stood all around and bowed down to my sheaf." (Genesis 37:6-7).

Examples in God's Word: Joseph (Genesis 37:5-10), Daniel (Daniel 7-12)

How do I interpret a dream or vision?

Speak to the Lord first. Interpretation belongs to Him (Genesis 40:8; Daniel 2:16). Trust Him to reveal His heart. Approach dreams or visions with humility, reverential awe and caution, guarding against pride or becoming preoccupied with extraordinary spiritual experiences.

Let us pray

- Remind the Lord of His promise to pour out His Spirit on all flesh and pray that **young and old in this generation** will dream dreams and see visions according to His Word.
- Ask that **future generations** yet to be born will serve Him faithfully.

SUNDAY 14 JUNE 2026

SIGNS

"I shall put a fleece of wool on the threshing floor; if there is dew on the fleece only, and it is dry on all the ground, then I shall know that You will save Israel by my hand, as You have said." (Judges 6:37).

Examples in God's Word: Gideon (Judges 6:36-40), Belshazzar – writing on the wall (Daniel 5)

A sign can be seen as confirmation of what the Lord has already revealed about a matter.

How to practise caution in asking God for a sign

Remain obedient to commands in God's Word. Resist the temptation of making decisions that relate to oneself; seek God's Kingdom first (Matthew 6:33).

Let us pray

- Pray for **people in positions of authority to learn about God**, His works and His commands from those who went before them.
 - Bring believers before the Lord who find themselves at crossroads in their life paths, to hear the voice of the Lord behind them saying, "This is the way, walk in it." (Isaiah 30:21).
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
