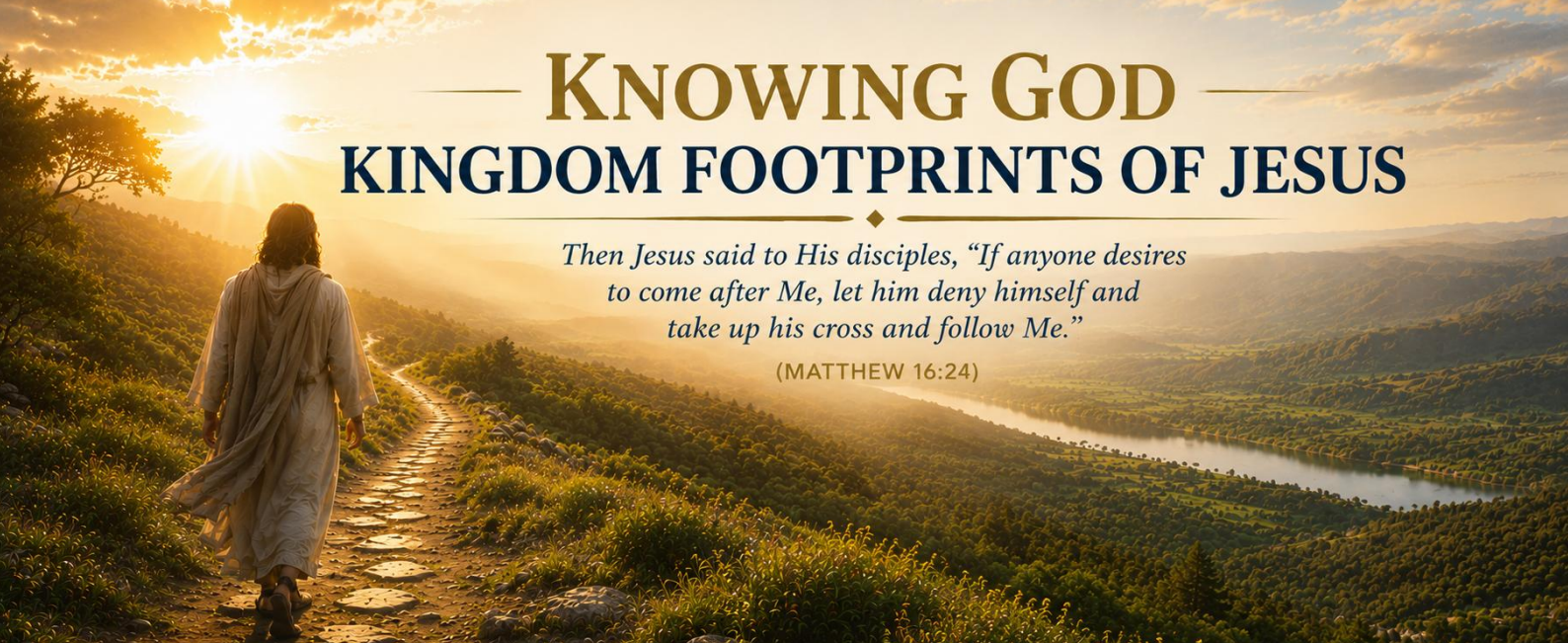

15-21 June 2026

To know God is more than knowing about Him; it is to seek His heart, walk closely with Him and respond to His voice. Throughout Scripture, God revealed Himself personally to those who sought Him with humility, faith and surrender.

We invite you to join us in prayer in this final week of the '*Knowing God series*', '**Kingdom Footprints of Jesus**'.

Together, we will reflect on the teachings and example of Jesus, considering His call to humility, obedience, purity and surrender – practical marks of those who truly follow in His footsteps and live according to the ways of His Kingdom.

MONDAY 15 JUNE 2026

THE CALL TO HUMILITY

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." (Matthew 5:3).

Read also

Luke 18:9-14 – Humility versus self-righteousness

Jesus walked throughout Galilee teaching that entrance into the Kingdom of God begins with humility and dependence upon the Lord. He confronted pride, self-righteousness and spiritual blindness, calling people to recognise their need for God. Eternal life belongs to those who humble themselves before Him.

Practical step

Choose today to serve someone quietly, without seeking recognition.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will humble the hearts of leaders and influential people in your city and awaken within them a true dependence upon God.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to convict those who trust in wealth, status or worldly success and draw them into repentance and surrender to Christ.

TUESDAY 16 JUNE 2026

HUNGERING FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS

"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled." (Matthew 5:6).

Read also

Psalms 119:9-16 – Desire to walk in purity and obedience to God's Word

As Jesus walked among the crowds, He taught that true followers of God must pursue righteousness from the heart. He confronted hypocrisy and empty religion, calling people to desire holiness, purity and obedience. Those who inherit eternal life are those who seek God's righteousness above all else.

Practical step

Spend time reading God's Word before turning to social media.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will awaken within His Church, schools and universities a deep hunger for righteousness, holiness and wholehearted obedience to Christ.
- Ask the Lord Jesus to expose compromise and awaken a desire for purity among the youth and young adults in your nation.

WEDNESDAY 17 JUNE 2026

A PURE HEART

"Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God." (Matthew 5:8).

Read also

Psalms 51:1-12 – David's prayer of repentance and cleansing

Jesus continually revealed that God looks beyond outward appearance and sees the true condition of the heart. As He walked among the people, He exposed hidden sin, wrong motives and hypocrisy. He taught that those who desire eternal life must allow God to cleanse and transform their hearts inwardly.

Practical step

Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal any hidden sin or wrong attitude that needs repentance.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will purify the hearts of spiritual leaders, teachers and those serving in ministry in your community.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to lead many people away from compromise and to establish purity, holiness and sincere devotion in their hearts.

THURSDAY 18 JUNE 2026
MERCY AND FORGIVENESS

"Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy." (Matthew 5:7).

Read also

Matthew 18:21-35 – Parable of the unforgiving servant

Jesus taught His followers that life in the Kingdom of God requires mercy, forgiveness and reconciliation. He confronted bitterness, hatred and unforgiveness, revealing that a transformed heart reflects the compassion and mercy of God. Those who walk in the footsteps of Jesus must learn to forgive as He forgave.

Practical step

Reach out to someone you need to forgive or encourage with kindness.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will bring healing, reconciliation and forgiveness within families, marriages and broken relationships in your church.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to uproot bitterness, offence and division within communities and restore mercy, unity and love.

FRIDAY 19 JUNE 2026
SEEK FIRST THE KINGDOM

"But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness..." (Matthew 6:33).

Read also

Luke 12:22-34 – Seek the Kingdom of God

As Jesus travelled through towns and villages, He warned people not to be consumed by earthly concerns, possessions and anxieties. He called His followers to place God's Kingdom above all worldly pursuits. Eternal life belongs to those who seek God wholeheartedly and trust Him completely.

Practical step

Set aside time today to pray before making important decisions or plans.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will turn the hearts of business leaders, working families and communities away from materialism and worldly distraction to seek first the Kingdom of God.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to restore spiritual focus among all people in your neighbourhood and awaken a desire to seek God above earthly gain.

SATURDAY 20 JUNE 2026

THE NARROW PATH

"Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it."
(Matthew 7:14).

Read also

Luke 9:23-26 – The cost of discipleship and following Christ

Jesus openly warned the crowds that not everyone would inherit eternal life. He taught that following Him requires surrender, obedience and perseverance. The narrow path confronts compromise, pride and sin, and leads to true life in the Kingdom of God.

Practical step

Choose obedience to Christ today, even if it costs comfort, popularity or convenience.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will awaken lukewarm pastors, ministry leaders and churches to the seriousness of eternity and the call to wholehearted obedience to Christ.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to strengthen the next generation to walk faithfully on the narrow path of truth and obedience.

SUNDAY 21 JUNE 2026

BUILDING ON THE ROCK

"Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine and does them, I will liken him to a wise man who built his house on the rock." (Matthew 7:24).

Read also

James 1:22-27 – Be doers of the Word and not hearers only

Jesus concluded the Sermon on the Mount by teaching that true disciples are not merely hearers of His words, but doers of them. He confronted shallow faith and warned that lives not built upon obedience to His teachings will not stand. Those who inherit eternal life are those who faithfully walk in His ways.

Practical step

Apply one teaching of Jesus practically in your home, relationships or daily conduct.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will strengthen families and households in your city to build their homes upon the truth and teachings of Jesus Christ.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to establish new believers in God's Word so that they may remain faithful and steadfast in Christ.
