

24-7 PRAYER FOR REVIVAL 3-9 AUGUST 2026

THE LOCAL CHURCH A HOUSE OF PRAYER FOR ALL NATIONS

Also the sons of the foreigner who join themselves to the LORD, to serve Him, and to love the name of the LORD, to be His servants... Even them I will bring to My holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of prayer... For My house shall be called a house of prayer for all nations.

(Isaiah 56:6-7)

The Lord Jesus loves His Church and desires every local congregation to reflect His heart and purposes. A healthy church is rooted in His Word, empowered by the Holy Spirit and devoted to prayer, worship and the proclamation of the Gospel.

During this week, we will pray for local churches to become houses of prayer where Christ is exalted, believers are equipped, the lost are reached and revival transforms communities.

MONDAY 3 AUGUST 2026

A CHURCH DEVOTED TO PRAYER

Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving. (Colossians 4:2).

Prayer is the heartbeat of a healthy church. Through prayer, believers seek God's will, receive His guidance and depend upon His power rather than human ability. A praying church becomes sensitive to the Holy Spirit's leading and is prepared for the work God desires to accomplish.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to restore a deep hunger for prayer in every local church, raising up believers who seek His face with perseverance, humility and faith until His purposes are fulfilled.
- Pray that every congregation will become a true house of prayer where the Holy Spirit is welcomed, Jesus Christ is honoured as Lord and God's presence transforms lives for His glory.

Practical tip

- Consider establishing a prayer room at a local church.

TUESDAY 4 AUGUST 2026

A CHURCH THAT LOVES GOD'S WORD

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path. (Psalm 119:105).

The Church remains strong when it is firmly established upon God's Word. Biblical truth equips believers, guards them against deception and leads the Church to maturity in Christ.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to give every local church a renewed love for His Word, raising up believers who diligently study, obey and proclaim the truth of Scripture with wisdom, conviction and humility.
- Pray for a dedicated group of people to pray for revival in local churches.

Practical tip

- Consider starting a weekly hour of prayer and Bible study for older adults.

WEDNESDAY 5 AUGUST 2026

A CHURCH FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me... (Acts 1:8).

The Holy Spirit empowers believers to live holy lives, proclaim the Gospel with boldness and minister according to God's will. The Church cannot fulfil her calling apart from His presence and power.

Let us pray

- Ask the Father to fill every local church afresh with the Holy Spirit, empowering believers to live holy lives, serve faithfully and proclaim the Lord Jesus Christ with boldness and compassion.
- Pray that God will raise up individuals in local churches to pray for revival.

Practical tip

- Consider prayerwalking or driving through a challenging area once a month, praying for revival there.

THURSDAY 6 AUGUST 2026

A CHURCH THAT PROCLAIMS THE GOSPEL

Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations... (Matthew 28:19–20).

The Lord has entrusted His Church with the Great Commission. Every local church is called to proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord faithfully and to make disciples who follow Him wholeheartedly.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Lord will renew the Church's passion for evangelism, giving believers courage, wisdom and compassion to proclaim the Gospel wherever He sends them.
- Ask the Lord to raise up individuals who will teach young people how to pray and help them find a place of prayer.

Practical tip

- Consider using social media to invite a friend to church or a Bible study this week.

FRIDAY 7 AUGUST 2026

A CHURCH WALKING IN LOVE, UNITY AND FORGIVENESS

...endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. (Ephesians 4:3).

Unity among believers displays Christ's character to the world. Forgiveness, humility and genuine love strengthen the witness of the Church and honour the Lord.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to heal broken relationships within His Church, removing division, offence and bitterness, and filling His people with genuine love, humility and forgiveness.
- Pray that the Lord will raise up people in the local church with a heart for prayer and evangelism.

Practical tip

- Spend five minutes before a service to pray for revival in the Church.

SATURDAY 8 AUGUST 2026

A CHURCH THAT DISCIPLES THE NEXT GENERATION

One generation shall praise Your works to another, and shall declare Your mighty acts. (Psalm 145:4).

The Church has the responsibility to teach children, youth and young adults to know the Lord Jesus Christ, love His Word and faithfully follow Him throughout their lives.

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to raise up parents, pastors, teachers and mentors who will faithfully disciple children, youth and young adults in the truth of God's Word and the ways of Christ.
- Pray that the Lord will raise up people in the local church to establish prayer groups that pray for revival in their community.

Practical tip

- Volunteer to serve in your church's children's or youth ministry.

SUNDAY 9 AUGUST 2026

A CHURCH BRINGING REVIVAL TO ITS COMMUNITY

You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. (Matthew 5:14).

A Spirit-filled church does not exist for itself. As believers love Christ, serve others and proclaim the Gospel, the Lord uses His Church to transform homes, schools, workplaces and entire communities through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Let us pray

- Pray that every local church will shine as the light of Christ within her community, demonstrating His love through faithful witness, compassionate service and unwavering obedience to His Word.
- Ask the Lord to establish every local church as a recognised house of prayer within its community, drawing people to the Lord Jesus Christ, awakening hearts to the Gospel and bringing lasting revival.

Practical tip

- When you attend the next service, consider praying with someone who needs prayer before leaving the church.
