"Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it;
have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air,
and over every living thing that moves on the earth."*

(Genesis 1:27a-28)

MONDAY 20 JULY 2026 STEWARDS OF CREATION

"... fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth." (Genesis 1:28).

God entrusted humanity with the responsibility of caring for His creation with His wisdom.

Modern-day example of godly stewardship: (Green Belt Movement)

Founded by Wangari Maathai in 1977, the Green Belt Movement has empowered communities, especially women, to plant millions of trees, restore degraded land, protect water sources and improve livelihoods.

Let us pray

- Pray that the Church will lead by example in caring for God's creation, demonstrating faithful stewardship in practical ways.
- Pray for those whose livelihoods depend on the land, forests, rivers and oceans, that God will provide for them and help them steward these resources wisely.

Act: Plant a tree, reduce waste, recycle, conserve water and spend time thanking God for His creation.

TUESDAY 21 JULY 2026

WISE STEWARDSHIP OF RESOURCES

Then the LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it. (Genesis 2:15).

God, the Creator of heaven and earth, has entrusted mankind with its resources to use it wisely so that the earth remains fruitful and sustainable.

Modern-day example of wise stewardship: Regenerative agriculture

Regenerative agriculture is a farming method that restores and improves soil health. By reducing chemical use, conserving water and increasing biodiversity, it produces food sustainably while protecting natural resources. [Read more](#)

Let us pray

- Pray for everyone involved in agriculture in your country, asking God to give them wisdom to adopt sustainable and environmentally responsible farming practices.
- Pray for scientists, conservationists and agricultural researchers, asking God to grant them insight to develop solutions that protect creation while meeting people's needs.

Act: Plant indigenous flowers or shrubs to attract bees, butterflies and birds in your outdoor space or garden to encourage pollination.

WEDNESDAY 22 JULY 2026

GOD'S PROVISION IN CREATION

And God said, "See, I have given you every herb that yields seed which is on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food. (Genesis 1:29).

God abundantly provides for our needs through His creation, from the air we breathe to the food we eat. May our gratitude inspire us to cherish and wisely care for the blessings He has entrusted to us.

Modern-day example: Community food gardens

Across the world, churches and communities are establishing food gardens that provide fresh fruit and vegetables for vulnerable families. These gardens demonstrate God's ongoing provision while encouraging responsible stewardship and generosity. [Read more](#)

Let us pray

- Give thanks to God for His abundant provision (Psalm 65:10-13; Psalm 104:10-24a).
- Pray for farmers, gardeners and those who work the land, asking God to bless their labour and provide favourable seasons.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to cultivate hearts of gratitude and contentment, helping us to trust God as our Provider and to avoid wastefulness.

Act: As a household, consider donating to a community food garden, volunteer firefighters, wildlife conservation, or an organisation protecting endangered species.

THURSDAY 23 JULY 2026

NATURE CONSERVATION

The earth is the LORD's, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. For He has founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the waters. (Psalm 24:1-2).

The Bible teaches that the earth and everything in it belongs to the Lord. As faithful stewards of the environment, we honour God by protecting it, preserving wildlife and helping His creation flourish.

Modern-day example: A Rocha

A Rocha is a global family of Christian conservation organisations caring for God's creation through conservation, research and environmental education. They also equip churches and communities to become faithful stewards of the environment. [Read more](#)

Let us pray

- Ask God to strengthen and protect conservation organisations, park rangers and environmental workers who protect wildlife and natural habitats.
- Pray against poaching, illegal wildlife trafficking and the destruction of natural habitats. Ask the Lord to expose criminal networks and bring justice.
- Pray that congregations will teach biblical stewardship of creation and inspire believers to care for the environment as an act of worship and obedience to God.

Act: Join hands with your local school or community to do an environmental or beach clean-up.

FRIDAY 24 JULY 2026

TEACHING FUTURE GENERATIONS

Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it. (Proverbs 22:6).

As stewards of creation, we are called to teach future generations to love, care for and protect God's creation. By setting a godly example, we leave a legacy of faithful stewardship for those who follow us.

Modern-day example: Rouxville Primary School, Cape Town

Learners in Rouxville Primary School's Environmental Club grow vegetables, herbs and fruit while learning sustainable gardening and environmental stewardship. The produce supplements the school's feeding scheme, with surplus shared or sold to support the garden, teaching children to care for God's creation through practical action. [Read more](#)

Let us pray

- Pray for the older generation to introduce children and young people to the joy of planting and harvesting.
- Ask the Lord to use these experiences to teach them godly principles, such as abiding in the Vine, depending on God and patiently waiting for His provision (John 15).
- Pray for parents, grandparents, teachers and church leaders to model faithful stewardship of God's creation through their words and actions.

Act: Ask permission at your school or church grounds to start a garden to supply food for the needy.

SATURDAY 25 JULY 2026

BLESSING ON THE LAND

'If you walk in My statutes and keep My commandments, and perform them, then I will give you rain in its season, the land shall yield its produce, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit. (Leviticus 26:3-4).

Throughout Scripture, God promises to bless His people as they walk in obedience to Him. He is faithful to provide seasonal rain, fruitful harvests and all that is needed according to His will.

Modern-day example: Planting in the dust - Angus Buchan

During a severe drought in KwaZulu-Natal, South African farmer Angus Buchan believed God had instructed him to plant potatoes, despite widespread warnings that the crop would fail without irrigation. As he prayed and trusted the Lord, God blessed the harvest abundantly. [Read more](#)

Let us pray

- Ask the Lord to strengthen farming families, agricultural workers and rural communities with His peace, provision and perseverance during difficult seasons like crop failure and financial pressure.
- Ask the Lord to help them seek Him daily, hear His voice and trust His Word.
- Pray for favourable weather, seasonal rain and protection from droughts, floods, pests and disease, asking God to bless the land with abundant harvests.

Act: Start or join a prayer group that prays about the agricultural matters in your nation.

SUNDAY 26 JULY 2026

RESTORING CREATION

When I shut up heaven and there is no rain, or command the locusts to devour the land, or send pestilence among My people, if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land. (2 Chronicles 7:13-14).

The beautiful creation around us is often harmed by pollution, deforestation and other human actions. As we acknowledge our mistakes before Him in prayer, we also act through practical means to restore and appreciate the world He made.

Modern-day example: Cape Town's Day Zero drought (2018)

During Cape Town's worst drought in over a century, Christians gathered at Mitchell's Plain in repentance and prayer, seeking God's mercy and asking for rain. In the months that followed, the winter rains came, dam levels rose and Day Zero (when the city would have run out of water) was avoided, alongside the faithful water-saving efforts of Cape Town's residents. Let us pray

- Pray that the Church will lead by example in repentance, faithful stewardship and practical care for God's creation, bringing hope to local communities.
- Pray that people in your community or city will recognise God's sovereignty over creation, turn to Him in repentance, and work together to restore and preserve the environment for His glory.
- Pray for government and community leaders to promote wise environmental stewardship in accordance with God's instructions.

Act: Join or organise a neighbourhood, river, or park clean-up to encourage others to help restore and protect the environment.
